God's Word warns us of our personal need to be spiritually ready for Jesus' return. This includes:

1. We must personally know Jesus as one's Savior and Lord. We must confess (agree with God) that we are sinners in need of a Savior (Romans 3:23, 6:23). By faith, we must accept Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection alone as the payment of our confessed (in God's power, repented of) sin (Romans 10:9–10, Ephesians 2:8–9).
2. Having believed in Jesus as Savior, we want to truly live for Him. We do not want to be found living a lackadaisical Christian life when Jesus returns (Mark 13:32–37; 2 Corinthians 5:10; 1 Corinthians 3:10–15)
3. The return of Jesus (Day of the Lord) will be joyous for all who are ready for His coming (Mark 13:32–37; Joel 2:18–26). However, "that day" will not be good for all who fail to be ready for Jesus' return (Amos 8:3–11; Zephaniah 1:9–10; Revelation 20:15).
