## Sermon Notes

*Be a "Man/Woman of God"*

*1 Timothy 6:11–12*

1. God calls for us to develop into a “man (woman) of God” (1 Timothy 6:11–16). This is a biblically rare designation for a person who is sold-out, in love with, and utterly committed to, God. “A man (or woman) of God” is one who “flees these things” (referring to the sinful tendencies of the false teachers (1 Timothy 6:3–10). “Fleeing” sin is a biblical concept. Some of the areas Godly people “flee” include:
  - a. Flee sexual immorality (1 Corinthians 6:18; Genesis 39)
  - b. Flee idolatry (1 Corinthians 10:14)
  - c. Flee youthful lust (2 Timothy 2:22)
  - d. Flee from the love of money (1 Timothy 6:11)
2. God calls us to grow in “righteousness, godliness, faith, love, steadfastness and gentleness” (1 Timothy 6:11).
  - a. We must balance orthodoxy (right thinking) with orthopraxy (right living), both done with gentleness (not arrogance)
  - b. A “man/woman of God” knows the difference between essentials of the faith (no compromise—ever) and fringe views where sincere, Godly Christ-followers may have slightly divergent views. This is wisdom.
