

**Philippians 2:9-11 (NIV)** <sup>9</sup> Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

**Revelation 19:16 (NKJV)** And He has on *His* robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

**James 4:1-3 (NIV)** <sup>1</sup> What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you? <sup>2</sup> You want something but don't get it. You kill and covet, but you cannot have what you want. You quarrel and fight. You do not have, because you do not ask God. <sup>3</sup> When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

**Romans 8:28 (NKJV)** And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose.

**John 6:38 (NKJV)** For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

**John 8:50 (NKJV)** And I do not seek My own glory; . . .

**John 8:28-29 (NKJV)** <sup>28</sup> Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am *He*, and *that* I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things. <sup>29</sup> And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him."

**John 10:17-18 (NIV)** <sup>17</sup> The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life--only to take it up again. <sup>18</sup> No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father."

We choose how much of our lives we surrender to God.

**Matthew 22:37-39 (NKJV)** <sup>37</sup> Jesus said to him, "*You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.*" <sup>38</sup> This is the first and great commandment. <sup>39</sup> And the second is like it: *'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'*

**Hebrews 4:12-13 (NKJV)** <sup>12</sup> For the word of God *is* living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. <sup>13</sup> And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things *are* naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we *must give* account.

**Philippians 3:12-14 (NKJV)** <sup>12</sup> Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. <sup>13</sup> Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

**Proverbs 3:5-8 (NKJV)** <sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. <sup>7</sup> Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil. <sup>8</sup> It will be health to your flesh, And strength to your bones.

**Galatians 2:20 (NKJV)** <sup>20</sup> I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

**Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)** <sup>11</sup> For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

**Proverbs 14:12 (NKJV)** There is a way *that seems* right to a man,  
But its end *is* the way of death.
