**2 Peter 1:2 - 4 (NKJV)** <sup>2</sup>Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, <sup>3</sup>as **His divine power has given to us all things that *pertain* to life and godliness,** through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, <sup>4</sup>by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption *that is* in the world through lust.

We don't have to GIVE UP anything. WE GET TO GET RID OF IT!

**2 Peter 1:2 - 4 (NKJV)** <sup>2</sup>Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, <sup>3</sup>as His divine power has given to us all things that *pertain* to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, <sup>4</sup>by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, **having escaped the corruption *that is* in the world through lust.**

**James 1:12 - 15 (NKJV)** <sup>12</sup>Blessed *is* the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. <sup>13</sup>Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. <sup>14</sup>But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires **(KJV lust)** and enticed. <sup>15</sup>Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.

**2 Peter 1:4 - 9 (NKJV)** <sup>4</sup>by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, **having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.** <sup>5</sup>But also for this very reason, (**because we have escaped the corruption**) **giving all diligence, add** to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, <sup>6</sup>to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, <sup>7</sup>to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. <sup>8</sup>For if these things are yours and abound, *you will be* neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>9</sup>For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.

This means controlling your passions rather than being controlled by them.

**2 Peter 1:8–10 (NKJV)** <sup>8</sup> For **if** these things **are yours** and **abound**, *you* will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>9</sup> For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, **and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.** <sup>10</sup> **Therefore**, brethren, **be even more diligent** to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble;

It is the **Promise, Power** and **Person** of Jesus that accomplishes all of this in our lives.

**John 17:18 (NLT)** **Just as you sent me into the world, I am sending them into the world.**

**1 John 3:8 (NKJV)** He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
