Ruined by Rotten Talk

Relationships Ruined and Restored

Relationships are ruined when you speak with <u>ROT</u> in your talk, but are restored when you use words that give <u>GRACE</u>.

Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. Ephesians 4:29

Proverbs 18:21 Matthew 15:11 James 3:8-10

Getting Rid of the Rot in our Talk

1. Prohibition: Don't Speak with CORRUPTING Talk!

What Is Corrupting Talk?

Corrupting talk is talk that is ROTTEN (Eph. 4:29a).

Ephesians 4:25, 31 Ephesians 5:4

Four Implications of Rotten Talk

- Rotten talk does not NOURISH.
- Rotten talk makes people SICK.
- Rotten talk makes the atmosphere <u>STINK</u>.
- Rotten talk comes from a rotten HEART.

2. Exhortation: Do Speak with EDIFYING Talk!

What Is Edifying Talk?

Edifying talk is talk that is good for BUILDING UP people (Eph. 4:29b).

T.H.I.N.K. Before You Speak

- **T** Are my words <u>TRUTHFUL</u>? *Proverbs 12:19*
- **H** Are my words HELPFUL? *Proverbs 25:11*
- I Are my words INSPIRING? 1Thessalonians 5:11
- **N** Are my words <u>NECESSARY</u>? *Proverbs* 10:19
- **K** Are my words KIND? *Proverbs 25:15*

3. Motivation: Make My MOUTH a Means of Grace Not Grief!

Two-Fold Purpose of Edifying Talk

- To give GRACE to the hearer who is around me (Eph. 4:29c).
- To not <u>GRIEVE</u> the Holy Spirit who is within me (Eph. 4:30).

Question for Our Mouths

Is my mouth a means of **GRACE** or **GRIEF** in my relationships?
