Review: What is the Hidden Word?

- The Hidden Word Is the *spiritual discipline* of Bible Memorization.
- The most important spiritual disciplines: Congregational Worship, Scripture Intake, and Prayer.
- Scripture Intake and Prayer are the *lifetime priority* of spiritual influencers and warriors.

Scripture Intake Takes Place Five Ways

"No Spiritual Discipline is more important than the intake of God's Word. Nothing can substitute for it." – Don Whitney

What Is the Hidden Word?

A Christlike discipline **empowered** by the Spirit and **encouraged** with accountability that **equips** us to **retain** God's Word in our hearts to **recall, reflect,** and **recite** it in the future as a mean of **promoting growth, guarding our hearts, and imparting grace** to ourselves and others!

Why Hide the Word?

"You do not need to memorize Scripture unless you clearly recognize the need." – N. A. Woychuk

"There are few disciplines Christians want to do more but actually do less than memorizing Scripture." – Tim Challies

"Many Christians consider the Spiritual Discipline of memorizing God's Word as something tantamount to modern-day martyrdom." – Don Whitney

"Memorizing is generally not a question of ability but of interest and desire. If you are truly interested and desire to do it, then you have already 'stepped on the starter,' and the engine of your brain is already running. **Motive in memorizing is basic. Intention predisposes the memory for retention. Motive is that which induces you to act.** You are interested, and you seize upon a particular portion of Scripture and purpose to spend time and mental resources in assimilating it. **Your persistence in memorizing it will depend almost entirely upon the extent of your interest.** – N. A. Woychuk, You Need to Memorize Scripture

1. The Hidden Word Will <u>CLEANSE</u> Us. Psalm 119:9-11

...Where We Need It Most and Only God Can Reach!

The Hidden Word Will Cleanse You for PURIFICATION!

Memorizing God's Word is not just for the pure of heart -- it's for those who want a pure heart!

"I considered my ways And turned my feet to Your testimonies." Ps 119:59 "I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek Your servant, For I do not forget Your commandments." Ps 119:176 You have rejected all those who wander from Your statutes, For their deceitfulness is useless. You have removed all the wicked of the earth like dross; Therefore I love Your testimonies." Ps 119:118-119

2. The Hidden Word Will <u>ARM</u> Us. Ephesians 6:17-18; Matthew 4:4, 7, 10-11

...for Spiritual Warfare Whenever Temptation Strikes!

- > The Hidden Word is **EXPLAINED** as the Spirit's weapon! Ephesians 6:17
- > The Hidden Word is **<u>APPLIED</u>** by the Son in warfare! *Matthew 4:1-11*

The Hidden Word Will Arm You for PROTECTION!

The Hidden Word Will Ready You for PERSEVERANCE!

4. The Hidden Word Will FILL Us. Ephesians 4:29; Colossians 3:16

...to Impart Grace When Encouraging, Exhorting, and Evangelizing Others!

Until the Word is hidden in our heart, it is not available for use with our mouth!

"Blessed are You, O LORD; Teach me Your statutes. With my lips I have told of All the ordinances of Your mouth." Ps 119:12-13 "And do not take the word of truth utterly out of my mouth" Ps 119:43 "I will also speak of Your testimonies before kings And shall not be ashamed." Ps 119:46

The Best Way to "Start" Memorizing Scripture Is Asking for God's Help:
