Ch 7:1–10:18 | Don't Settle for LESSER When You ALREADY Have BETTER in JESUS' Eternal, Perfecting Priesthood: The Perfected Son Is Seated & Serving as Our High Priest in the Heavenly Sanctuary with a Better Ministry!

BETTER MEDIATOR Like Melchizedek 7:1-28 BETTER MINISTRY in Heaven 8:1-6 BETTER COVENANT with Better Promises 8:7-13

BETTER SANCTUARY Not Made by Man 9:1-10

Question: Why does the pastor-teacher begin with the better COVENANT? Hebrews 7:12, 22; Isaiah 42:7; 49:8

Old Is Not Always Better!

When the "old" is no longer functioning and has become obsolete, then it's time to **HOLD FAST** to the "new" and don't look back!

What Is Covenant? A Bond in Blood!

A bond *(relational commitment with responsibilities)* in blood *(life and death consequences)* between two parties that is sovereignly initiated, especially with an oath and blood sacrifices after the Fall.

What Are the Biblical Covenants?

God's Creation Plan (Gen 1:26-28; 2:7-25) and God's Redemption Promise (Gen 3:15) are fulfilled through the Noahic Covenant (Gen 8:15–9:17), the Abrahamic Covenant (Gen 12; 15; 17; 22), the Mosaic Covenant (Ex 19–24), the Davidic Covenant (2 Sam 7:1-17), and ultimately the superiority of the New Covenant (Jer 31:31-34) in and through the better ministry of Jesus, the exalted Priest-King, who is both the divine Son of God and the human Son of Adam, Abraham, Judah, and David!

Why Is the New Covenant Better than the Old?

1. The Old Covenant Was Good but FAULTY. (8:7-8a)

Why Was the Old Covenant Law Good and Even Gracious?

- **RESTRAINS** sinfulness. (Galatians 3:24; 1 Timothy 1:9-10)
- REVEALS the depravity and inability of the human heart. (Romans 3:20)
- > REFLECTS the need for Christ to fulfill what the Law pointed to and pictured. (Hebrews 8:5; Matthew 5:17-18)
- **REMINDER** of who God always is and what He always requires of His people: Be holy for I am holy by grace through faith in My promised Son. (1 Corinthians 10:1-13; Romans 15:4; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Book of Hebrews)

Why Was the Old Covenant Law Faulty?

- The external Law written on stone CANNOT perfect anyone or anything internally or eternally. (7:9)
 - 1. **LOGICAL** faultiness. (8:7; 2 Cor 3:7-9)
 - 2. **QUALITY** faultiness. (8:6, 8, 10-12; 2 Cor 3:10)
 - 3. TEMPORAL faultiness. (8:5, 7, 8, 10, 13; 2 Cor 3:11)

2. The New Covenant Has Better PROMISES. (8:9-12)

Four Better Promises

I will **COMPLETE** a New Covenant for rebel sinners! (vv. 8, 10a)

Observations

- 1. God's grace alone:
- 2. Restoring Israel as a Nation
- 3. Unconditional Covenant
- I will **WRITE** My laws on hearts by My Spirit! (v. 10b; Ezekiel 36:26-27)
- > I will **BE** their God and they will be My people personally and eternally! (vv. 10b-11; Galatians 3:28)

"There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus."

> I will REMEMBER their sins no more. PERIOD! (v. 12; Matthew 26:26-29; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26)

Observations

- 1. This receives the **DOUBLE** "I WILL" like completing the covenant did.
- 2. Impossible without the once for all **SACRIFICE** of our *Priest-King* as our *Sinless Substitute* and *Sufficient Sacrifice!*

As our *sinless sacrifice* He is the **GUARANTEE** of this better covenant! (7:22, 27)
As our *eternal high priest* He is the **MEDIATOR** of this better covenant! (8:6)
