Magnify the Lord with Your Witness

Lesson 3 · Luke 1:39-45

Mary's LifeSong Magnified the LORD not HERSELF!

We don't venerate Mary as equal to the Lord; we **IMITATE** her faith in exalting the Lord.

Overview of the Passage

- > The ANNUNCIATION by the Angel Gabriel to Mary. (vv. 26-38)
- > The **VISITATION** by Mary to Her Relative Elizabeth. (vv. 39-45)
- The MAGNIFICATION of the LORD by Mary in song. (vv. 46-56)

Observations of the Annunciation and Visitation Passages

- 1. Greetings of GOOD NEWS trigger both passages.
- 2. Gabriel's greeting is by GRACE alone while Mary's greeting is through FAITH alone.
- 3. We know the content of Gabriel's greeting but only the CONSEQUENCES of Mary's greeting.

Before the focus was on the **MESSAGE from the LORD** to Mary but now the focus is on the **MESSIAH who is the LORD** in Mary!

4. The **PRESENCE** of the Lord in Mary's womb is the focus of everything: Jesus is in the house!

The Moment Elizabeth Hears Mary's Greeting Two Things Happen (vv. 40-41)

- John the six-month-old unborn baby LEAPS for joy by the filling of the Holy Spirit. (cf. 1:15)
- Elizabeth the barren, old pregnant mother **<u>SHOUTS</u>** for joy by the filling of the Holy Spirit.

JESUS is in the HOUSE! Let's JUMP and SHOUT for JOY!

5. Elizabeth shouts a three-fold **BLESSING** for what God has done and is doing!

The Three Blessings

- #1 Blessed is Mary among all women: **Chosen** by God's grace from among all women for this honor!
- #2 Blessed is the fruit of your womb: **Conceived** by the Holy Spirit while still a virgin!
- #3 Blessed is she who believed God keeps His promises: **Committed** to the Lord by grace alone through faith alone!
- 6. Mary, Elizabeth, and John are Spirit-filled WITNESSES to the joy of knowing Jesus even when He's just conceived!
 - Our culture calls a baby an "embryo" from conception to 8-weeks but the Bible calls an "embryo" a "baby"!
 - Our culture calls a baby a "fetus" from 8-weeks to birth but the Bible calls a "fetus" a "baby"!

1. The Spirit Enables Us to <u>WITNESS</u> for the Lord.

- > Notice WHO is witnessing to Jesus in this passage. Acts 1:6-11
- > Notice *HOW* they are witnessing to Jesus in this passage. Acts 4:23-31

2. The Spirit Enables Us to <u>REJOICE</u> in the Lord.

Witnessing is NOT a BURDEN WE BEAR but a JOY WE SHARE!

- > Notice *HOW* much joy is in this visit to Elizabeth's home.
 - John *leaps for joy* in the womb!
 - Elizabeth *shouts for joy* in her home!
 - Mary *sings for joy* in the Magnificat!

JESUS is in MY HEART: I can't help but JUMP and SHOUT and SING!

> Joy is the **second characteristic** of the Fruit of the Spirit and **big theme** in Luke-Acts.

3. The Spirit Enables Us to <u>WORSHIP</u> the Lord as the Triune God.

- > The Spirit reveals to us the **TRIUNE** God who is fulfilling His plan of redemption.
 - 1. The Triune God at work in the Annunciation. (v. 35)
 - The Holy Spirit will come upon you.
 - The Most High will overshadow you.
 - The Holy Child will be called the Son of God.
 - 2. The Triune God at work in the Visitation. (vv. 41-44)
 - The Holy Spirit fills John and Elizabeth to reveal...
 - The Lord is the fruit of Mary's womb because...
 - The **Father** has fulfilled what He has spoken.
- > Our witness is the **OVERFLOW** of worshipping the Triune God with great joy! (Ephesians 5:15-21)

How Do We Magnify the Lord Like Mary?

By daily being filled with the Spirit, so we can witness to others as we worship the Lord with great joy!
