What Is the Hidden Word?

A Christlike discipline **empowered** by the Spirit and **encouraged** with accountability that **equips** us to **retain** God's Word in our hearts to **recall**, **reflect**, and **recite** it in the future as a mean of **promoting growth**, **guarding our hearts**, **and imparting grace** to ourselves and others!

The Stimulus: Five More Benefits of the Hidden Word!

5. The Hidden Word Will REMIND Us for *Prevention*. Deuteronomy 6:1-15

Remember the <u>WORD</u> of the Lord to remember the <u>LORD</u> of the Word, so you fear Him, serve Him, and obey Him above all others!

Apathy toward the Lord is a result of amnesia! Not fearing the Lord is due to forgetting His Word!

The Hidden Word Will Remind Us to Not Forget the Lord When Life Is Good!

- Don't forget to **SERVE** the Lord. (vv. 12-15)
- Don't forget to <u>SUCCEED</u> with the Lord. (Joshua 1:8)
- Don't forget to SUBMIT to the Lord. Ps 119 4-6, 17, 34, 44-45, 59-60, 106, 145

6. The Hidden Word Will MOTIVATE Us for Pondering & Perceiving. Joshua 1:8; Psalm 1:1-3

"Muttering" leads to memorizing and memorizing leads to "muttering"!

The Hidden Word Will Motivate Us to Meditate on God's Wisdom Whenever and Wherever!

"Unless you memorize Scripture you will not meditate on it day and night." - John Piper

 - 1. God's **WORD**. Joshua 1:8; Ps 119 Acrostic Psalm for Memorizing & Meditating!
 - 2. God's WILL for Our Walk. Ps 119:1, 35, 45; cf. 1:1-2; 40:8; 86:11; 143:8, 10
 - 3. God's **WAYS**. Ps 119:5-6, 15, 27, 29-31, 33, 104; 27:11; 32:8; 86:11; cf. 27:11; 32:8; 86:11
 - 4. God's **WORKS/WONDERS**. *Ps 119:27; 77:12; 143:5; 145:5*
 - 5. God WHOLLY. Ps 119:55, 132; 27:4; 145:5
- WHERE Do We Meditate? Ps 4:4; 63:6, 27:4
- WHEN Do We Meditate? Joshua 1:8; Ps 119:97, 148; 63:6; 77:6

7. The Hidden Word Will GUIDE Us for Pursuing & Parenting. Ps 119:105; Deuteronomy 6:6-9

Guidance on pursuing GODLINESS. Ps 119:105, 35

"For a man without the Word is a blind man without a guide." – Puritan Richard Rogers

- Guidance in Godly PARENTING. Deuteronomy 6:6-9; 4:9; 11:18-21
 - 1. <u>HIDE</u> God's Word in your own heart first. (v. 6) "These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart." (v. 6) ESV
 - 2. **IMPRESS/INSCRIBE** God's Word on your children.

"You shall teach them diligently to your children..." (v. 7a) "Impress them on your children." NIV

3. **APPLY** God's Word with your children.

"and shall talk of them..." (vv. 7b-9)

Four Prime Times to Apply the Hidden Word with Your Children

- Dinner time "when you sit in your house"
- Drive time "when walk by the way"
- Bedtime "when you lie down"
- Wake time "when you rise up"
- Any time "You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes."
- All the time "You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."
- 4. **RETAIN** God's Word for your children's children.

"You shall bind them...You shall write them..." (vv. 8a, 9a)

8. The Hidden Word Will TRANSFORM Us for Pleasure. Psalm 40:8; 119:16

"I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within my heart." Psalms 40:8
"I will delight myself in Your statutes; I will not forget Your word. Psalms 119:16

- Greater **JOY** in the Word. Ps 119:14, 16, 24, 35, 47, 56, 70, 77, 92, 97, 111, 127, 143, 162, 174
- Greater <u>LOVE</u> for the Word. Ps 119:47-48, 97, 113, 119, 127, 132, 159, 163, 165, 167
- Greater CONTENTMENT with the Word. Psalm 119:14, 19, 57, 72, 103, 127, 162
- Greater LONGING for the Word. Ps 119:20, 81, 123, 131, 174

9. The Hidden Word Will ENLARGE Us for Praising. Psalm 119:32

"I shall run the way of Your commandments, For You will enlarge my heart." Psalm 119:32

- A bigger heart for greater **THANKS** to God. *Ps 119:7, 164, 171-172, 175*
- A bigger heart for greater FEAR of God. Ps 119:38, 41, 55, 68, 89-91, 114, 137-138, 142, 152, 160, 166
