# What's the Big Idea? Keep Moving Forward or Fall Away into Fiery Judgment!

Anyone who <u>FALLS AWAY</u> from the faith will certainly <u>FALL INTO</u> the fiery judgment of the living God! The person who *falls away* from Jesus as their great High Priest (10:19-21), *forsaking* His assembled people (10:22-25), will certainly *fall into* the hands of the living God, who is a consuming fire with terrifying judgment for His enemies (10:26-31).

# Warning: Keep Moving Forward or Fall Away into Fiery Judgment!

- 1. The Willful Sin of Falling Away RESULTS in the Fearful Judgment of God's Fiery Wrath. (vv. 26-27)
  - The warning is for TRUE believers not to commit this willful sin of falling away.

# What is the sin?

- 1. Generally: The rebellion of **APOSTASY** as in all the other warnings.
- 2. Specifically: The refusal to **PERSEVERE** as exhorted in vv. 19-25.

#### How is this sin committed?

- 1. **PERSISTENTLY**. "go on sinning," "keep on sinning, "persist in"
- DELIBERATELY. "willfully," "persist in"

# Who is being warned about committing this sin?

True believers **INCLUDING** the pastor-teacher himself!

"we," vv. 19-21; "let us," vv. 22-25; "we who know Him," v. 30)

# Wake-Up Warning for True Believers Including the Pastor-Teacher:

Don't commit this willful, persistent sin of apostasy by **REFUSING** to obey the calls to "let us" draw near, hold fast, and stir up in order to persevere to the Day that is drawing near!

- The warning is about the FEARFUL judgment by God's fiery wrath. (vv. 26a-27)
  - 1. **SALVATION** is definitely being rejected. "there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins"; cf. 10:18.
  - 2. **JUDGMENT** will certainly be received. "but a terrifying expectation of judgment..."
    - The **frightening certainty** of judgment. "but a terrifying certainty...of judgment"
    - The fiery consumption of judgement. "and the fury of fire which will consume"
    - The future condemnation of judgment. "the adversaries [of God]." Isaiah 26:11

### The Five Warning Passages Warn of Divine Judgment...

where there is "no escape" (2:2; 12:25) from God's wrath (3:10, 17) for falling short of His eternal rest (3:11, 18–19; 4:1, 6, 11). A condition where there no sacrifice remains or possibility of repentance for someone (6:4-6; 10:26; 12:16-17) but only a fearful expectation of fierce, frightening, fiery judgment (10:27; 12:29), a death that utterly destroys without mercy (10:28, 39), and the terror of failing into the hands of the living God who is a consuming fire (10:27, 30–31; 12:29),

Therefore, we must conclude that **eternal damnation** (6:2) is the consequence for those who ignore God's warnings and refuse His exhortations to persevere.

# Wake-Up Warning for True Believers Including the Pastor-Teacher:

Don't commit this sin of apostasy and suffer **ETERNAL**, conscious torment in the Lake of Fire.

# 2. The Fearful Judgment Will Be GREATER Under the New Covenant. (vv. 28-29)

The Book of Hebrews: Continuity with Discontinuity and the Superiority of Fulfillment with Escalation!

## The Judgment for Apostasy Under the Old Covenant

> PHYSICAL DEATH without mercy on the testimony two or three witness. (v. 28; Deuteronomy 29:14-21; Hebrews 12:15-17)

## The Judgment for Apostasy Under the New Covenant

> SPIRITUAL DEATH without mercy on the testimony of the Triune God. (v. 29)

"How much severer punishment do you think he will deserve...?"

#### The Apostasy and the Witnesses Are Three Times Greater

- 1. **TRAMPLING** underfoot God the Son with contempt.
- 2. TREATING the blood of God the Father's New Covenant as common. (cf. 2:11; 9:13; 101:10, 14, 29; 12:14; 13:12)
- 3. **TAUNTING** God the Spirit who is the Gift of grace and the Giver of grace to apply the covenant.

# 3. The Fearful FACT of Falling Away into the Hands of the Living God for Judgment. (vv. 30-31)

"For we know Him who said, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY." And again, "THE LORD WILL JUDGE HIS PEOPLE."

It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God." Hebrews 10:30-31; Deuteronomy 32:35-36

# Don't Forget This Fearful Fact: Keep Moving Forward to Our Final Salvation or Fall Away into Fiery Judgment!

Anyone who willfully falls away from the faith will certainly fall into the fiery judgment of the living God!

I believe the "Means of Salvation" view is the most consistent with the Book of Hebrews and the rest of the Bible.

# 2. The PARALLELISM Is INTERESTING. (These are abbreviated to show a chiastic structure and understand them as a whole.)

#### **WARNING #1 | 2:2-3**

"For this reason we must **pay much closer attention** to what **we heard**, so we don't **drift away** from it. For how will we escape if we **neglect** so great salvation? After it was first spoken...**how will we escape if we neglect** so great a salvation"

#### **WARNING #2 | 3:7-8, 12**

"Today if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts...Take care, brethren, that there not be in any one of you an evil, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God."

## **WARNING #3 | 6:4-6**

"Concerning [Melchizedek] we have much to say, and it is hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing. For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you have need for someone to teach you...milk not solid food...For in the case of those who have once been enlightened and have tasted of the heavenly gift and have made been made partakers of the Holy Spirit, and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, and [if they fall] away, it is impossible to renew them again to repentance..."

#### WARNING #4 | 10:26-29, 31

"For if we go on sinning willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, but a terrifying expectation of judgment and the fury of fire which will consume he adversaries...Anyone who sets aside the Law of Moses dies without mercy...How much more severe punishment do you think he will deserve who trampled underfoot the Son of God...It is a terrifying thing fall into the hands of the living God."

#### WARNING #5 | 12:25, 28-29

"See to it that **you do not refuse** [the God with the Unshakeable Kingdom] who is **speaking**. For if those [OT Rebels] did not escape when they refused [God] who warned them on earth, **much less will we escape who turn away from** [God] who warns from heaven...let us show gratitude, by which we offer to God an acceptable service [as believer-priests] with reverence and awe; for **our God is a consuming fire**."

# 4. The PUNISHMENT INTENSIFIES.

Warning #1 A just penalty that is inescapable like in the Old Testament only greater. (2:2-3)

Warning #2 Not entering God's rest like those who died in the wilderness. (3:12; 4:1-3, 11)

Warning #3 Cursed with being burned without the possibility of repentance. (6:4-8)

Warning #4 The judgment is more fierce, forceful, frightening, and fiery than under the Old Covenant (10:26-31)

Warning #5 Compared to Esau who never repents and faces God who is a consuming fire. (12:17, 25, 28-29)

# 6. The PURPOSE Is INSPIRED: Sovereign Means for Sovereign Ends!

Warnings are one of God's sovereign means to ensure true believers will persevere to the end!

"It is evident from [Hebrews] 6:4-6 that the writer addresses Christians, that he warns believers about what will happen if they fall away. His purpose in the warning isn't to pause and to say, 'Some of those I am addressing are not truly believers.' Believers are addressed in the admonitions...the warnings were a means used to preserve them in the faith until the end. Another way to put it is this: the author doesn't attend to a question that often holds our attention. He doesn't consider whether some of those addressed aren't truly believers, for to do so would be to distract him from his main purpose and would blunt the force of the warning." – Tom Schreiner

> There's **no middle ground** for spiritual sluggards and those who willfully refuse to move forward by drawing near without fear by faith, holding fast to the last in hope, and stirring up to keep up in love with one another as the Day of our final rest and future salvation draws near!

## Who Has ALREADY Fallen Away Among These Believers?

No one yet...but some have already made it a habit of forsaking assembling together as a local church! (10:24-25)

## Who WON'T FALL AWAY but Are WARNED to Not Fall Away Among These Believers?

The elect whom God securely keeps by grace through persevering faith in heeding the warnings to stay fixated on Christ's greater glory, hold fast to their confession of the Son as their High Priest, and who move forward together with confidence to enter God's final rest.

# Who MIGHT VISIBLY FALL AWAY Among These Believers?

Those who profess Christ but have not united by faith in the gospel with those who are persevering to the end.

# 7. The PRACTICE Is INDISPENSABLE: Stay Fixated on These Five Gospel Warnings!

They are God's gospel-centered means for finishing faithful as true believers and not falling away from Christ!

- God wants us to take these warnings seriously as a means of grace for preserving as believer priests.
- God wants us to stay fixated on the exalted Christ and the gospel by looking upward with confidence instead of inward with doubts.
- Sod wants us to be secure in our salvation and sure of our salvation by showing the "better things...that accompany salvation" and "not throwing away our confidence which has great reward" nor "shrinking back to destruction, but being those who have faith to the preserving of the soul" (6:9; 10:35, 39).
