The Angels' Song

A Reason to Sing

A <u>SAVIOR</u> is born, glory to God and peace on earth.

For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. Luke 2:11

And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom He is pleased!" Luke 2:13-14

The Angels' Song

1. The Angel Proclaims GOOD NEWS of Great Joy!

What Is the Good News of Great Joy?

It's about the <u>BIRTH</u> of a Savior, but it also includes a death and resurrection (v. 8-12).

The Birth of a Savior

- A Savior is born "this day in the city of DAVID."
- A Savior is born "who is Christ the LORD."
- A Savior is born "for unto YOU."

2. The Angels Proclaim God's GLORY and Our PEACE!

What Does the Savior's Birth Mean?

It means God is glorified in the highest and on earth <u>PEACE</u> is spread everywhere the Savior is received (v. 13-14).

Peace on Earth

- Peace with GOD (Rom. 5:8; 8:6-7)
- Peace with OURSELVES (Phil. 4:6-7)
- Peace with OTHERS (Rom. 12:18; Eph. 4:31-32)

God's Solution for Experiencing Peace

No Christ = <u>NO PEACE</u> Know Christ = KNOW PEACE
