Lesson Three • Genesis 18:9-15

Why Did You Laugh?

God's Question: "Why did you laugh?"

God wants to transform our cynical laughter of DOUBT into a joyful laughter of belief in His promises.

The LORD said to Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh and say, 'Shall I indeed bear a child, now that I am old?'" Genesis 18:13

Transforming Laughter of Doubt into Laughter of Belief

1. God Brings Us to a Humble PLACE at the End of Our Strength...

Three Reasons Behind Our Cynical Laughter of Doubt

- We assume that God's work is limited to a certain TIME FRAME.

- We assume that God's work is limited to our OWN ABILITIES.

- We assume that God's work is limited to those who never FAIL HIM.

Problem with Assumptions

Our assumptions stem from a human perspective that leaves GOD OUT, therefore God confronts us in our doubt.

2. ...So We Will Trust God's Sovereign GRACE to Do the Impossible!

Joyful Laughter of Belief

God REWARDS us when we trust His sovereign grace to do the impossible.

The LORD visited Sarah as He had said, and the LORD did to Sarah as He had promised. And Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son in his old age at the time of which God had spoken to him. Abraham called the name of his son who was born to him, whom Sarah bore him, Isaac. Genesis 21:1-3

By faith Sarah herself received power to conceive, even when she was past the age, since she considered Him faithful who had promised. Hebrews 11:11
