Magnify the Lord with Your Worship

Lesson 4 • Luke 1:46-56

Overview of the Passage

- The **ANNUNCIATION** by the Angel Gabriel to Mary. (vv. 26-38)
- The VISITATION by Mary to Her Relative Elizabeth. (vv. 39-45)
- The MAGNIFICATION of the LORD by Mary in song. (vv. 46-56)

"We have in these verses, the announcement of the most marvelous event that ever happened in this world, the incarnation and birth of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is a passage which we should always read with mingled wonder, love and praise." – J. C. Ryle

Mary's Magnificat

- Could a young, teenage virgin ever write such a song?
- What stands out about Mary's Song?

Magnify the Lord with Your WORSHIP of the Son's Kingdom Reversals!

Mary is inviting us to join the *Jesus revolution* that is a *reversal* of the how the world lives.

Kingdom Reversals that Magnify the Lord

- 1. The Lord Is MAGNIFIED not Us. (vv. 46-47)
 - Mary <u>BEGINS</u> where all true worship begins: God-centered!
 - True NT worship is always centered on our TRIUNE God not merely a generic "God."

2. The Lord Is MINDFUL of the Humble. (vv. 46-50)

Mary Avoids the Two Extremes in Church History: Making Too Much or Too Little of Herself.

How? By staying God-centered in her worship!

Mary's Song Rejoices in the Fulfillment of Isaiah's Servant Songs!

- 41:8-20 Yahweh says the nation Israel is "My Servant" whom I will HELP (3x) on the basis of covenant election and covenant loyalty to Israel despite of her disloyalty and rebellion.
- 42:1-9 Then Yahweh says Messiah is "My Servant" who is My elect and who I put My Spirit on "to bring forth justice to the nations" and "in the earth." And "I will appoint you as a covenant to the people, as a light to the nations..."
- 42:10-13 Therefore, Israel is to "SING a NEW SONG to the LORD, SING His PRAISE from the end of the earth" just like Mary!

Magnify the Lord for Being the Mindful of the Humble!

What the Lord did for Mary as a humble believer He does for all who humble themselves before Him and His Son.

- Anyone in any nation and every generation no matter how low you go will be will DELIVERED.
- Everyone who fears Him and runs to Him by faith alone will be FORGIVEN.
- Everyone who humbly confesses their sinfulness and neediness will receive MERCY.
- > Everyone who lives this way daily and doesn't become proud, self-reliant, and independent will be **BLESSED**.

3. The Lord Is MIGHTIER Than the Proud. (vv. 51-53)

The Magnificat functions as a PIVOT in the fulfillment of God's redemptive history.

Looks back to the past at all the Lord has done for Israel especially in the Exodus redemption.

Looks inward in the present at what the Lord is doing in Mary's womb with the Lord's incarnation.

Looks forward to the future to all the Lord will do in the mighty reversals at the Kingdom consummation.

➤ God's people stay on **MISSION** until the King comes with His Kingdom reversals.

Spiritual Reversal - Acts 1:6-8

4. The Lord Is MERCIFUL to the Repenter. (vv. 54-55)

- Remember Mary is echoing Isaiah's Servant Songs especially Isaiah 41:8-20; 42:1-13.
- Israel as a nation must humble themselves and **REPENT** to receive God's mercy and be restored by the ultimate kingdom reversal.

Acts 3:17-21; Micah 7:18-20; Psalm 98:1-9

All of these KINGDOM REVERSALS will finally and literally be fulfilled when the KING COMES AGAIN to REDEEM the NATIONS, RESTORE ISRAEL and REIGN FOREVER!

How Do We Magnify the Lord Like Mary?

By joyfully worshipping the Son for His Kingdom reversals and doing our part to reach the nations until the King comes to restore the Kingdom to Israel!

Magnify the Lord with Your Witness with the Spirit's Daily Filling!

Magnify the Lord with Your Worship for the Son's Kingdom Reversals!
