Who Is Jesus to You?

The Fifth Sign

Jesus is our PEACE in the storms of life as the Savior-King.

"Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand." Isaiah 41:10

Walking On a Stormy Sea

1. Jesus SENDS Us into the Storm!

Disciples in the Storm

- There is DARKNESS in the storms of life (v. 16-17).
- There is DIFFICULTY in the storms of life (v. 18-19a).
- There is DELAY in the storms of life (v. 17).

2. Jesus COMES to Us in the Storm!

Jesus Walking on the Sea

- Jesus comes to RESCUE us in the storm by His power (v. 19-20).
- Jesus comes to REASSURE us in the storm by His presence (v. 19-20).

3. Jesus BRINGS Us Out of the Storm!

Jesus in the Boat

Disciples gladly took JESUS into the boat, and immediately they reached their destination on the other side of the sea (v. 21).

Disciples' Mixed Response

- Disciples WELCOMED Jesus into their boat but not yet into their hearts (Mk. 6:51-52).
- Disciples WORSHIPED Jesus, declaring Him the Son of God (Mt. 14:33).

Takeaway

Jesus is the SAVIOR-KING over a stormy sea who we desperately need. Therefore, welcome Him into your heart and worship Him as your Savior-King, and He will be your peace in the storms of life.

Two Miracles with One Message

Jesus is more than enough in any given situation as the all-sufficient and all-powerful Savior-King.

COMMUNION

Remembering Jesus Is More Than Enough

Followers of Jesus Christ (those who trust Christ for salvation, identify with Christ in baptism, and commit to Christ's body in membership of a local church of like faith and practice) are invited to participate in Communion located at the four tables in the auditorium. **After you take the bread and cup back to your seat, PLEASE WAIT so we may eat and drink together.** The bread and juice represent the body and blood of Jesus when He died on the Cross and reminds us who our Lord is, what He has done for us, is doing for us, and will yet do for us when He returns.
