Everything We Will Ever Need When It's the Name of the "I Am" God!

Life-threatening crisis can come to any one of us at anytime...

What will you do when a life-threatening crisis enters your life or the life of a loved one?
Where are you going to turn? Or better...to whom are you going to turn?

1. A Life-Saving DESIRE John 11:1-3

2. A Life-Costing DELAY John 11:4-6

Four Lessons on the Lord's Delays in Life's Crisis

- His delays are <u>PLANNED</u>. (v. 6)
- 2) His delays are **PURPOSEFUL**. (v. 4)
- 3) His delays are **PERSONAL**. (vv. 3, 5)
- 4) His delays are never PERMANENT / FINAL.

3. A Life-Threatening DECISION John 11:7-16

Five Lessons on Following the Lord into Life Threatening Situations

- 1) We are unstoppable until we have **COMPLETED** the work God has called us to do. (vv. 9-10)
- The <u>BEST</u> place in all the world is the center of God's will, even if it is not always the safest. (v. 10)
- 3) Those who truly **LOVE** the Lord and others are willing to sacrifice their lives in serving others. (vv. 11-14; 15:12-14)
- 4) We do not seek martyrdom, but to fulfill the mission with a faith that obeys and a love that sacrifices. (v. 15-16)

"If anyone would come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me." Mark 8:34 "When Jesus calls a man to follow him he bids him come and die." ~Dietrich Bonhoeffer

5) For the faithful follower death is not the end, but the **BEGINNING**. (v. 11, 15)

4. Life-Revealing DECLARATIONS John 11:17-32

Three Life-Revealing Declarations by the I Am God:

- 1) "I am the resurrection and the life." (v. 25a)
- 2) "He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live." (v. 25b)
- 3) "And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die." (v. 26)


5. Life-Raising DEMANDS John 11:33-44

Four Demands Made by the I Am God in the Face of Death:

1) A demand regarding the Place of Death: "Where have you laid him?" (vv. 33-37)

Two Powerful Emotions Shown by Our LORD in the Face of Death:

- Human **SADNESS** over the loss of His beloved friend (v. 35)
- ♦ Holy **ANGER** at the consequences of sin and unbelief in who He really is. (v. 33, 36-38)
- 2) A demand regarding the *Perspective* of Death: "Take away the stone!" (vv. 38-42)
- 3) A demand regarding the **Permanence** of Death: "Lazarus, come forth!" (vv. 38-40)
- 4) A demand regarding the **Pull** of Death: "Loose him, and let him go!" (vv. 44)
