# JACOB: God's Rascal in the Grip of God's Grace

Lesson Six • Genesis 27:41 - 28:9

## **Tragedy of Sin & Triumph of Grace**

### Tragedy of Sin & Triumph of Grace

When we <u>SEEK</u> our own way, we never get all we wanted and we pay a high price for what we do get. But when we <u>SURRENDER</u> our ways to God, we will never be more blessed than in the grip of God's grace.

### Tragedy and Triumph in Three Acts

## Act 1: A Faithless SON Embracing His Sin

#### Esau's Faithless Heart

- Esau HATED Jacob so much for stealing the blessing that he plotted to kill him (Gen. 27:41).
- > Esau never <u>REPENTED</u> of his sin and turned to God for grace and mercy (Heb. 12:17).

# Act 2: A Deceptive MOM Holding On to Her Ways

### Rebekah's Deceptive Heart

- Rebekah <u>INSTRUCTED</u> Jacob to flee to Haran for a few days after learning about Esau's intent to kill him (Gen. 27:42-45).
- Rebekah <u>INFLUENCED</u> Isaac to send Jacob away to Haran for one reason while hiding her real reason (Gen. 27:46).

# Act 3: A Surrendered DAD Blessing His Son

#### Isaac's Surrendered Heart

Isaac finally surrendered his <u>WILL</u> to God when he "trembled very violently" realizing at that moment God's will was sovereign (Gen. 27:33).

### Isaac's Faithful Act

- lsaac DIRECTED Jacob not to take a Canaanite wife (Gen. 28:1-5).
- Isaac <u>BLESSED</u> Jacob with faith-filled sincerity (Gen. 28:1-5).

### Esau's Faithless Act

Esau <u>MARRIED</u> a third wife from Ishmael's family desperately seeking another way to earn his father's blessing (*Gen. 28:6-9*).

#### **Takeaway**

<u>FAILURE</u> to honor God's Word never results in blessing, but <u>FAITHFULNESS</u> to honor God's Word always results in blessing.
