Commending the Gospel

As Servants of God

Our lives will either COMMAND the gospel or become OBSTACLES to the gospel.

Therefore, compelled by the love of Christ, we “bend over backward” for the sake of the gospel, so that God may be glorified in the salvation of more people.

Commending the Gospel

1. We APPEAL to Everyone to Receive God’s Grace!

Passionate Commitment

We make God’s appeal urgently because NOW is the day of salvation (v. 1-2).

- We commend the gospel by displaying GRACES of the Spirit (v. 6-7).
- We commend the gospel by maintaining INTEGRITY in all of life (v. 8-9).
- We commend the gospel by embodying the PARADOX of the gospel (v. 9-10).

Question for Servants of God

Are you ready for your life to be HARD for the sake of the gospel?

Being an ambassador for Christ who is engaged in the mission of gospel reconciliation will be difficult.

But through the gospel, we discover the power to command the gospel with our lives rather than becoming obstacles to the gospel.
