Summer in the Psalms

Lesson Seven • Psalm 24
The King of Glory

Main Point of Psalm 24

Worship the KING OF GLORY, the One who has made a way for every person to enter God's presence and who is coming again.

Question in Psalm 24

Who is THIS King of glory?

Who Is This King of Glory?

1. He's the CREATOR-KING: Recognize His Greatness in Creation!

The Greatness of the Creator-King

- He OWNS it all; the earth is completely His (v. 1).
- He CREATED it all; the earth is rightfully His (v. 2).
- He SUSTAINS it all; the earth is predictably His (v. 2).

2. He's the SAVIOR-KING: Receive His Grace in Salvation!

Most Important Question

Who may APPROACH God in worship and stand in His holy presence (v. 3)?

The Grace of the Savior-King

- He demands HOLINESS in approaching Him (v. 4).
- He gives RIGHTEOUSNESS in seeking Him (v. 5-6).

3. He's the WARRIOR-KING: Rejoice in His Coming in Victory!

The Coming of the Warrior-King

- Worship the King of glory who is MIGHTY in battle (v. 7-8).
- Worship the King of glory who is COMING again (v. 9-10).

Takeaway

Seek Jesus like JACOB sought God, trusting Him as your Creator-King, Savior-King, and Warrior-King.

*Such is the generation of those who seek Him, who seek the face of the God of Jacob.
Psalm 24:6 ESV*

*This is the generation of those who seek Him, who seek Your face—even Jacob.
Psalm 24:6 NASB*

Genesis 32:22-32 – The story of Jacob wrestling with God and refusing to let go until God blessed him
