## The PROBLEM We Have ~ John 10:6

We Are All Like Lost Sheep Without a Shepherd.

Jesus uses shepherding as a powerful word picture to show us that we have a profound spiritual problem.

The Problem of Lost Sheep  Matthew 9:36; Mark 6:34	The Provision of the Good Shepherd Numbers 27:16; 1Kings 22:17; John 10
We Are Harassed Wanderers Bullied & Bewildered, Beaten & Bruised	We Need the Staff of Sacrificial Leadership Compassion that Does Not Use the Sheep
We Are Helpless Wanderers  Cast Down = Fallen & Can't Get Up!	We Need the Rod of Strong Leadership Correction that Does Not Abuse the Sheep

# The PROVISION We Need ~ John 10:11, 14

The "I AM God" Is the Good Shepherd Who Always Finds His Own Sheep!

### **Eight Characteristics of the Good Shepherd**



- 1) As a **Submitted Leader** the Good Shepherd **enters** through the Door of the sheepfold. (2-3; 4:34; 5:30; 6:38-40)
- 2) As a **Selective Leader** the Good Shepherd **calls** His own sheep. (3)
- 3) As a **Sensitive Leader** the Good Shepherd **knows** His own sheep by name. (3, 14-15, 27)
- 4) As a Saving Leader the Good Shepherd leads His sheep out of the fold into good pasture. (3, 9)
- 5) As a Safe Leader the Good Shepherd goes before His sheep as an example. (4; 13:15)
- 6) As a **Secure Leader** the Good Shepherd **secures** His sheep from eternal harassment & spiritual helplessness.
- 7) As a **Sacrificial Leader** the Good Shepherd **dies** for His sheep. (11-15, 17-18)
- As a Sovereign Leader the Good Shepherd rises to reign for His glory and the good of His sheep. (17-18)

# If You Have Lost Your Way, Let Jesus the Good Shepherd Lead You!

## The PROOF We Have Been Found~ John 10:22-30

Lost Sheep Who Have Truly Been Found Will Always Follow the Good Shepherd!

## Seven Marks of True Sheep

- 1. True sheep **RECOGNIZE** and **relish** hearing the Good Shepherd's voice. (vv. 3-5, 27; 1John 4:1-6)
  - Those who are Christ's sheep will accept those who declare Him according to His Word.
  - Those who are Christ's sheep will reject those who deny Him or His Word.



- 2. True sheep <u>RESPOND</u> to the Good Shepherd's call by entering through the right gate/door and following Him. (vv. 7-9, 3-4, 27)
  - Those who are Christ's sheep respond by <u>BELIEVING</u> in Him: John 9:35-38; see also 8:30
    Those who are <u>not</u> His sheep do <u>not</u> believe: 10:6, 19-21, 24, 31, 33, 39; see also 7:40-53; 8:13, 19, 22, 25, 27, 33, 48, 52-53, 57, 59; 9:16, 24-34, 40
  - Those who are Christ's sheep respond by <u>FOLLOWING</u> Him: John 10:3-4, 27; Mark 10:51-52
    Those who are <u>not</u> His sheep do <u>not</u> persevere in following Him: John 6:66-69
- 3. True sheep **RETURN (RECIPROCATE)** the Good Shepherd's love. (vv. 14-15)
- 4. True sheep **RELATE** with the one flock and the one shepherd. (v. 16; 11:50-52)
  - True Sheep prove they love the Good Shepherd by loving His Sheep: 1John 3:10-11, 14, 16-18, 23; 4:7-12, 16-21; 5:2
  - True Sheep prove they love the Good Shepherd by serving His Sheep: John 21:15-19
- 5. True sheep **REPRODUCE** the Good Shepherd's example in themselves and others. (v. 4; 1John 2:6)
- 6. True sheep **REST** in the Good Shepherd's secure protection. (vv. 28-30; 1John 5:12-13)
- 7. True sheep **REJOICE** in the Good Shepherd's gift of life. (vv. 10, 17-18, 28)
  - ⇒ He gives His sheep abundant life (vv. 10)
  - ⇒ He gives His sheep *resurrection* life (vv. 17-18)
  - ⇒ He gives His sheep eternal life (v. 28)



# Jesus Is the Good Shepherd! Let Him Lead You!

"I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own...My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me."
