The Most Important Question You'll Ever Answer

The Most Important Question You'll Ever Answer

Who is WORTHY to be in God's presence?

Only the one who MEASURES UP to God's standard is worthy to be in God's presence.

*O LORD, who shall sojourn in Your tent? Who shall dwell on Your holy hill?
Psalm 15:1*

The Most Important Question You'll Ever Answer

1. The Question That STOPS Us!

The Question

How GOOD does one need to be to live in God's presence and render Him worship (v. 1)?

2. The Answer That SEARCHES Us!

The Answer

The one who is RIGHTEOUS may live in God's presence and enjoy fellowship with Him, for a holy God requires a holy people (v. 2).

Profile of the Righteous

- The CHARACTER of the righteous is blameless (v. 2).

- The CONVERSATION of the righteous is truthful (v. 3).

- The CONDUCT of the righteous is godly (v. 4-5).

3. The Promise That SETTLES Us!

The Promise

The righteous will never be MOVED—they are safe and secure in God's tent (v. 5).

The Ultimate Problem

None of us are WORTHY to live in God's presence—none of us are good enough.

The Lord looks down from heaven on the children of man, to see if there are any who understand, who seek after God. They have all turned aside; together they have become corrupt; there is none who does good, not even one. Psalm 14:2-3

Enter not into judgment with your servant, for no one living is righteous before You. Psalm 143:2

The Ultimate Solution

JESUS CHRIST is worthy, and we receive His righteousness through faith in Him.

For our sake He made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God. 2 Corinthians 5:21

Live It Out Lesson from Psalm 15

Trust in Jesus for your righteousness and then live RIGHTEOUSLY in the power of God's Spirit.

As obedient children, do not be conformed to the passions of your former ignorance, but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy." 1 Peter 1:14-16
