

Luke 9:28-36

Exodus

I. A New Thing vv.28,29

Translation — “And it happened that about eight days after this conversation when He had taken Peter and John and James aside He went up into the mountain to pray.” v.28

Translation — “And while He was praying the appearance of His face changed and His garment became dazzlingly white.” v.29

II. 2 New Guys vv.30-32

Translation — “And Look! Two men began to talk with Him, who were Moses and Elias.” v.30

Translation — “Who having made a glorious entrance began to discuss with Him His exodus which He was in the process of completing in Jerusalem.” v.31

Translation — “But Peter and the men with him had been overwhelmed by sleep; however when they awakened they saw His glory and the two men who had been standing with Him.” v.32

III. A New Blunder vv.33,34

Translation — “And it happened that while they were taking their leave of Him, Peter said to Jesus, ‘Master, it is good for us to be here. In fact, let us build three tabernacles — one for you and one for Moses and one for Elijah,’ not realizing what he was saying.” v.33

Translation — “But as he was saying these things a cloud gathered and began to overshadow them. And they were seized with fear as they entered into the cloud.” v.34

IV. A New Direction vv.35,36

Translation — “And a voice spoke from the cloud, saying, ‘This man is my Son, the Chosen One. Listen to no one but Him.’” v.35

Exodus

Translation — “And when the voice ceased, Jesus was found alone. And these remained silent. In fact in those days they did not tell to a single person one part of that which they had experienced.” v.36
