1. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>: "WHEN YOU CHANGE THE WAY YOU LOOK AT THINGS, THE THINGS YOU LOOK AT CHANGE".

2. GRACE

- A. <u>PRINCIPLE</u>: God never calls us to a task without giving us what you need to do it. He never sends us without going with us.
 - 1. GOD DOESN'T <u>ALWAYS CALL THE EQUIPPED</u>... <u>BUT</u> HE <u>ALWAYS EQUIPS</u> THE CALLED... IF WE ASK HIM AND ALLOW HIM TO DO SO.
 - 2. Many, many fathers and mothers carry a **PARTICULAR PROBLEM** into their **PARENTING**, and **THEY DO NOT KNOW IT**.
 - a. It **AFFECTS** the way we **THINK ABOUT** the **TASK OF PARENTING** that has been **ASSIGNED TO THEM.**
 - b. It AFFECTS the way we VIEW OUR CHILDREN.
 - c. It **SHAPES** our **RESPONSES** in all the hard moments that parents face.
 - d. It **DETERMINES WHAT WE WILL SAY** to ourselves as we begin their day or as we crumble into bed, exhausted once again.
 - e. It LEAVES MANY PARENTS feeling UNPREPARED, UNABLE, AND DISCOURAGED.
 - f. It **CAUSES MANY PARENTS** to wish that they could just **QUIT**, when they know in fact **THEY CANNOT**.
 - g. It MAKES PARENTS GIVE IN TO THE TEMPTATION TO <u>SAY</u> AND <u>DO</u>

 THINGS that they know in their heart of hearts they <u>SHOULDN'T SAY</u>
 and <u>SHOULDN'T DO</u>.
 - 3. WHAT IS THIS SILENT, BUT DEADLY, <u>PROBLEM</u> THAT <u>AFFECTS SO MANY PARENTS</u>?..... Far TOO MANY <u>CHRISTIAN PARENTS</u> have a <u>HUGE GAP</u> in their UNDERSTANDING and RELIANCE ON GOD'S GRACE.

- a. There is <u>NOTHING MORE IMPORTANT</u> to <u>CONSISTENT</u>, <u>FAITHFUL</u>, <u>PATIENT</u>, <u>LOVING</u>, AND <u>EFFECTIVE</u> PARENTING THAN TO <u>UNDESTAND</u> WHAT GOD HAS GIVEN US IN <u>GRACE</u> THROUGH HIS SON, the LORD JESUS CHTIST.
 - 1) I HEAR YOU... "RUSTY, I don't need more <u>THEOLOGY</u>; I need PRACTICAL HELP!!"
- b. PLEASE BEAR WIH ME because this may be ONE OF THE MOST

 IMPORTANT SECTIONS IN THIS CLASS. WE WILL GET TO PRACTICAL

 HELP AND SPEND A LOT OF TIME ON IT.
 - 1) FOR TODAY UNDERSTANDING GOD'S GRACE WILL CHANGE YOU, AND AS IT CHANGES YOU, IT WILL CHANGE THE WAY YOU PARENT YOUR CHILDREN.
 - 2) "WHEN YOU CHANGE THE WAY YOU LOOK AT THINGS, THE THINGS YOU LOOK AT CHANGE".
- B. It is **SAD**, and a source of so much **PARENTING DISCOURAGEMENT**, that so many parents do their work in the middle of a **HOLE in OUR GRASP OF GOD'S GRACE**.
 - 1. **MOST CHRISTIAN PARENTS** have a fairly good understanding of **PAST GRACE** (JUSTIFICATION), that is, the **FORGIVENESS** we have received because of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.
 - 2. We have a decent grasp of **FUTURE GRACE** (**GLORIFICATION**), the place in eternity that is guaranteed us as a child of God.
 - 3. **But** the **PROBLEM** is that we have **LITTLE UNDERSTANDING of PRESENT GRACE** (**SANCTIFICATION**), WHERE PARENTING IS CONCERNED.
 - a. The right here, right now **BENEFITS OF THE WORK OF JESUS FOR ALL OF US LIVING BETWEEN THE "ALREADY" (past grace)** and the "NOT YET" (future grace).

- 4. Vast numbers of parents think that the phrase "the GOSPEL of GOD'S GRACE" has NOTHING TO DO WITH THE TRIALS OF PARENTING.
 - a. We hear <u>SERMONS</u> ABOUT <u>GOD'S GRACE</u> and we <u>SING SONGS</u> ABOUT <u>GOD'S GRACE</u>, <u>BUT</u> they <u>DO NOT</u> seem to address our STRUGGLES AS PARENTS.
 - b. So it NEEDS to be <u>SAID</u> and then <u>EXPLAINED</u> that as a child of God, you have been given not only glorious <u>PAST GRACE</u> and <u>FUTURE</u> <u>GRACE</u>, <u>BUT</u> amazing <u>PRESENT GRACE</u> as well.
- 5. <u>PRESENT GRACE</u> (SANCTIFICATION) reaches you <u>WHEREVER GOD HAS</u> <u>PLACED YOU</u>.
 - a. THIS GRACE reaches you in your darkest parenting moments.
 - b. THIS GRACE addresses your feeling of inability.
 - c. THIS GRACE touches you when you feel you are at the end of your wisdom.
 - d. THIS GRACE is yours for the taking when you're walking down the hallway and you know that you've just blown it.
 - e. THIS GRACE reaches you when your child seems rebellious and hardhearted and you don't know what to do.
 - f. THIS GRACE touches you in moments of deep parental regret.
- 6. If you were to ask, "WHAT IS THE MOST IMPORTANT THING GOD HAS GIVEN US AS A PARENT, I WOULD NOT SAY THE WISDOM PRINCIPLES OF HIS WORD".
 - a. NO... I WOULD SAY "HIS GRACE"
 - b. Let me explain WHY...
- C. Like everything else **GOD CALLS PEOPLE TO DO... GOD <u>DOES NOT</u> CALL PEOPLE TO BE PARENTS BECAUSE WE ARE ABLE.**
 - 1. PEOPLE IN THE BIBLE WHO WERE NOT ABLE....

- a. Abraham wasn't able.
- b. Moses wasn't able.
- c. **Gideon** wasn't able.
- d. **David** wasn't able.
- e. The disciples weren't able,
- f. AND NEITHER ARE WE!
- g. ABLE PEOPLE JUST DO NOT EXIST... AND THEY <u>CERTAINLY DO NOT EXIST AS PARENTS!</u>
- 2. God did <u>NOT</u> create human beings to be <u>INDEPENDENTLY ABLE</u>... He <u>DESIGNED US TO BE DEPENDANT</u>... ON HIM!
 - a. So **QUIT BEAING YOURSELF UP** because you feel **INADEQUATE as a PARENT**... you feel that way **BECAUSE IT IS TRUE**!
- 3. WHY would a God of <u>PERFECT WISDOM</u> ask <u>INADEQUATE PEOPLE</u> to do such an <u>IMPORTANT JOB</u> AS <u>PARENTING</u>?
 - a. The **ANSWER** is **VERY IMPORTANT** for us to grasp....
 - b. GOD CALLS <u>UNABLE PEOPLE</u> to do IMPORTANT THINGS because ultimately what he's working on is <u>NOT OUR IMMEDIATE SUCCESS</u>, <u>BUT</u> that we would COME TO <u>KNOW HIM</u>, to <u>LOVE HIM</u>, to <u>REST IN HIS GRACE</u>, and <u>LIVE FOR HIS GLORY</u>.
 - c. Let me put it a different way... God calls <u>UNABLE PEOPLE</u> to DO <u>IMPORTANT THINGS LIKE PARENTING</u> so that <u>HE WILL GET HE</u> GLORY... and NOT US.
 - d. GOD isn't working so that our life as a <u>PARENT</u> would be <u>EASY</u>, PREDICTIBLE, AND FREE FROM STRUGGLE.
 - e. He calls us to do the IMPOSSIBLE so that in our SEARCH FOR HELP, WE WILL FIND MORE THAN HELP... WE WILL FIND HIM!

- D. God <u>NEVER</u> CALLS US TO A TASK WITHOUT <u>GIVING US WHAT WE NEED TO</u> DO IT.
 - 1. God NEVER SENDS US INTO ANYTHING WITHOUT GOING WITH US.
 - 2. Rather than **OUR INABILITY** being **IN THE WAY OF GOD'S PLAN**, it is **PART OF HIS PLAN!**
 - 3. GOD KNOWS THAT PARENTS WHO ADMIT THAT THEY ARE INADEQUATE, AND TURN TO HIM FOR THEIR SUFFICIENCY, MAKE THE BEST PARENTS.
 - a. He DOES NOT ASK US TO BE ABLE... HE ASKS US TO BE WILLING.
 - b. <u>IF</u> WE are WILLING, He <u>WILL</u> MEET US in our WEAKNESS and <u>CHANGE US</u>, and AS HE CHANGES US, HE <u>WILL</u> WORK GOOD THINGS THROUGH US INTO THE HEARTS AND LIVES OF OUR CHILDREN.
- E. NO CHILD REALLY <u>WANTS TO BE PARENTED</u> BY PARENTS <u>WHO THINK THEY</u>
 <u>ARE "ABLE".</u>
 - 1. WHY?.... "ABLE" PARENTS TEND TO BE PROUD AND SELF-ASSURED PARENTS.
 - 2. BECAUSE "ABLE" PARENTS ARE <u>PROUD</u> OF THEIR <u>ABILITY</u>, THEY <u>ACT</u> TOO QUICKLY AND WITH TOO MUCH SELF-CONFIDENCE.
 - a. ... and because they do, THEY LACK <u>PATIENCE</u> AND <u>UNDERSTANDING</u>.
 - b. "ABLE" PARENTS tend to ASSUME that THEIR CHILDREN SHOULD BE "ABLE", TOO.
 - 1) SOOO, THEY TEND TO <u>FAIL</u> TO BE <u>TENDER</u> WHEN THE <u>WEAKNESSES</u> OF THEIR CHILDREN GET <u>EXPOSED</u>.

"ABLE" PARENTS, who <u>PRIDE THEMSELVES</u> in KEEPING THE <u>LAW</u>, tend to give their children MORE <u>LAW</u> (RELIGION)THAN <u>GRACE</u> (RELATIONDHIP) and are QUICKER TO <u>JUDGE</u> THAN TO <u>UNDERSTAND</u>.

- c. And "ABLE" PARENTS tend to WANT THEIR CHILDREN TO BE THEIR TROPHIES... A PUBLIC DEMONSTRATION OF THEIR ABILITIES.
 - 1) "ABLE" PARENTS ARE OFTEN REFFERED TO AS "HELICOPTER
 PARENTS" BECAUSE THEY WANT TO MAKE SURE THER CHILDREN
 ARE MIRRORS OF THEIR "ABILITY".
- d. It's <u>HARD TO LIVE WITH</u> PARENTS WHO <u>DENY WEAKNESS</u>, BECAUSE PEOPLE WHO <u>DENY WEAKNESS</u> TEND <u>NOT</u> TO BE <u>PATIENT</u>, <u>LOVING</u>, AND <u>UNDERSTANDING</u> WITH PEOPLE/CHILDREN THEY SEE AS WEAK.
 - 1) THEY TEND PRODUCE <u>CHILDREN</u> WHO ARE <u>NOT PATIENT</u>, LOVING, AND UNDERSTANDING.
- F. OUR <u>INABILITY</u> is <u>NOT</u> THE <u>DESTRUCTION</u> OF <u>OUR PARENTING</u>, BECAUSE <u>GOD MEETS PARENTS WHO HUMBLY ADMIT THEIR WEKNESSES</u> AND <u>RUN</u> TO HIM FOR HELP.
