PARENTING BY THE BOOK

1. PROCESS

- A. PRINCIPLE: You must be committed as a parent to LONG-VIEW PARENTING because CHANGE is a PROCESS and NOT AN EVENT.
 - 1. We want <u>PARENTING</u> to be a <u>SERIES OF EVENTS</u> rather than a <u>LIFELONG</u> PROCESS.
 - a. So in <u>MOMENTS OF DISCIPLINE</u> we get cranked up emotionally and think that if we are **STEARN** enough and **LOUD** enough, and make **THREATS** that are **BIG ENOUGH**... we will win, and **our children will INSTANTLY CHANGE**.
 - b. Think about how God the Father **WORKS CHANGE OUR LIVES** as his children.
 - We have been fully <u>JUSTIFIED</u> and completely accepted... but we are NOT COMPLETE, because there is massive CHANGE that needs to take place in us.
 - a. IN OTHER WORDS: the <u>POWER</u> OF SIN HAS BEEN BROKEN, BUT the <u>PRESENCE</u> OF SIN still REMAINS and will be <u>PROGRESSIVELY</u> <u>ERADICATED</u>.
 - b. The most important word in the last sentence is **PROGRESSIVELY**.
 - c. The Father's work of <u>JUSTIFICATION</u> is an <u>EVENT</u>... <u>BUT</u> his work of <u>SANCTIFICATION/TRANSFORMATION</u> is literally a <u>LIFE-LONG</u> <u>PROCESS</u>.
 - d. When <u>JUSTIFYING</u> you, God is fully aware that he is **committing** himself to a <u>DAY-BY-DAY PROCESS</u> of illumining, confronting, convicting, forgiving, transforming, and delivering <u>GRACE</u>.
 - 3. PARENTING is <u>NOT</u> a <u>SERIES</u> of <u>DRAMATIC CONFRONTATION-CONFESSION EVENTS</u>... <u>BUT</u> rather a <u>LIFE-LONG PROCESS</u> of <u>INCREMENTAL AWARENESS</u> and <u>PROGRESSIVE CHANGE</u>.
 - 4. A <u>MISUNDERSTANDING</u> of what you've been <u>CALLED TO AS A PARENT</u> WILL <u>ALWAYS</u> SET UP <u>UNREALISTIC EXPECTATIONS</u> OF OUR <u>CHILDREN</u>

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and <u>FRUSTRATIONS AS A PARENT</u> that WILL TEMPT US TO <u>DO</u> AND <u>SAY</u> THINGS THAT WE SHOULD NOT DO OR SAY.
