- 1. <u>STEP 1</u> WHEN GIVING INSTRUCTIONS TO A CHILD <u>DO NOT GET DOWN TO YOUR CHILD'S EYE LEVEL</u>.
 - A. **DO NOT** BEND DOWN OR GET ON YOUR KNEES.
 - 1. LOOK LIKE AN AUTHORITY FIGURE.
 - B. PARENTS THAT GET DOWN BY BENDING AT THE WAIST OR GET DOWN ON THEIR KNEES... **DO NOT LOOK LIKE AUTHORITY FIGURES.**
 - 1. THEY LOOK LIKE **SUPLICANTS**.
 - a. THEY LOOK LIKE SOMEONE WHO IS **PLEADING WITH "HIS/HER MAJESTY".**
 - b. "STOP THAT!"
 - c. IT DOES NOT HELP.
 - C. WHEN YOU **SPEAK TO YOUR CHILD**... **LOOK LIKE AN AUTHORITY FIGURE**.
- 2. <u>STEP 2</u> WHEN CONVEYING INSTRUCTIONS TO YOUR CHILD, USE THE FEWEST WORDS POSSIBLE.
 - A. IF YOU WANT YOUR CHILD TO **PUT ON HIS'HER COAT... SAY "<u>PUT ON YOUR</u>** <u>COAT"</u>.
 - 1. IF YOU WANT YOUR CHILD TO PICK UP THEIR TOYS... SAY "PICK UP YOUR TOYS".
 - B. THAT MAY SOUND ROBOTIC, AND I MAY AGREE, BUT I'M NOT ENCOURAGING YOU TO SOUND LIKE AN UNLOVING PARENT.
 - 1. THE **FORMULA** CONSISTS OF <u>6 EQUALLY IMPORTANT STEPS</u>... AND WE'VE ONLY COVERED **TWO OF THEM**.
- 3. <u>STEP 3 PREFACE</u> THE FEWEST WORDS POSSIBLE <u>WITH AN AUTHORITAVE</u> <u>PHRASE LIKE... "IT'S NOW TIME FOR YOU TO"...</u> OR "I WANT YOU TO"... OR "YOU'RE NOW GOING TO".
 - A. SO "PUT ON YOUR COAT"... BECOMES "IT'S NOW TIME FOR YOU TO PUT ON YOUR COAT".

- B. OR "I WANT YOU TO PICK UP YOUR TOYS AND PUT THEM WHERE THEY BELONG".
- C. MANY PEOPLE THINK THAT APPROACH IS **CALOUS AND UNLOVING**, AND BRANDS US AS SUCH.
 - 1. YES, YOU <u>CAN</u> TALK LIKE THAT AND BE <u>NASTY</u>... <u>OR</u> YOU CAN TALK LIKE THAT AND BE <u>SERIOUS</u> AND <u>LOVING AT THE SAME TIME</u>. IT'S ALL A MATTER OF CONTEXT.
 - a. AND THE <u>CONTEXT</u> CAN BE A <u>RELAXED</u>, <u>EASY GOING PARENT-CHILD</u>
 <u>RELATIONSHIP</u>.
 - 2. THE IDEA IS FOR THE CHILD TO KNOW WHO IS IN CHARGE, AND REALIZES THAT COMPLIANCE WITH AN AUTHORITY FIGURE THAT HAS HIS/HER BEST INTREST IN MIND IS A GOOD THING.
 - a. AND THAT **OBEDIENCE** IS **HOW A CHILD SHOWS RESPECT.**
 - 3. EVERY CHILD NEEDS AUTHENTIC ADULTS THEY CAN LOOK UP TO, AND FEEL COMPLETELY SAFE WITH.
- D. NOTE: THE MOTHER'S AUTHORITY IN THE HOME IS EVERY BIT AS ABSOLUTE AS THAT OF HER HUSBAND.
 - 1. <u>HOWEVER</u>... THAT DEPENDS ON THE CHILDREN SEEING THAT, DAD IS THE <u>FINAL AUTHORITY</u> ON MATTERS CONCERNING THEM BECAUSE IF <u>SOMEONE</u> IS <u>NOT</u> THE FINAL AUTHORITY...
 - a. IT BECOMES A "JUMP BALL" BETWEEN MOM AND DAD.
 - b. <u>IF IT BECOMES A "JUMP BALL"</u> BETWEEN MOM AND DAD... THE <u>CONSEQUENCE</u> IS <u>ONE ARGUMENT AFTER ANOTHER</u> BETWEEN MOM AND DAD.
 - c. IF THE KIDS <u>DO NOT</u> SEE THAT <u>DAD</u> IS THE <u>FINAL AUTHORITY</u> THEN THEY <u>LEARN HOW TO MANIPULATE BOTH MOM AND DAD</u>.
- 4. STEP 4 DO NOT EXPLAIN YOUR DECISIONS TO YOUR CHILDREN.

- A. PARENTS GAVE OUR CHILDREN LIFE, AND WE DO WHATEVER IS NECESSARY TO SUSTAIN THEIR LIVES.
- B. OUR <u>PARENTAL AUTHORITY</u> IS <u>GIVEN TO US BY GOD</u>... AND BECAUSE OF THAT WE ARE <u>NOT REQUIRED</u> TO JUSTIFY OUR DECISIONS TO OUR <u>CHILDREN</u>.
 - 1. <u>BUT RUSTY... A COUNSELOR</u> ONCE TOLD ME THAT <u>CHILDREN SHOULD</u>

 <u>KNOW WHY</u> PARENTS GIVE THE <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u> WE GIVE AND MAKE
 THE DECISIONS WE MAKE.
 - a. THAT IS WHAT **MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITIES** BEGAN SAYING IN THE 1960s AS PART OF THEIR **POST MODERN PSYCHOLOGICAL PARENTING PARADIGM**.
 - **b.** LOOK AROUND... <u>HAS IT WORKED?</u>... <u>NO</u>! IT HAS BEEN A DISASTER!
 - c. THAT NARRATIVE HAS...
 - 1) HARMED CHILDREN
 - 2) MADE CHILD-REARING A STRESSFUL ENTERPRISE
 - 3) DESTROYED MARRIAGES
 - 4) AND IS DESTROYING PUBLIC EDUCATION.
- C. **EXPLANATIONS LEAD TO ARGUMENTS!**
 - 1. MANY PARENTS WHO SAY THAT THEY HAVE "AN ARGUMENTATIVE CHILD" MAY ACTUALLY HAVE A CHILD WHO IS RESPONDING REFLEXIVELY TO PARENTAL EXPLANATIONS, DECISIONS, AND INSTRUCTIONS OF WHAT THE PARENT WANTS DONE.
 - a. INSTEAD OF TELLING THE CHILD WHAT THE PARENT WANTS DONE, THEY INCLUDE TELLING THE CHILD "WHY" THEY WANT HIM/HER TO DO WHAT THEY ASK.
 - b. <u>BEFORE</u> PARENTS GET THROUGH TELLING THEIR CHILD WHAT THEY WANT DONE... THE CHILLD STARTS TO ARGUE.

- 1) THE CHILD <u>ISN'T ARGUMENTATIVE</u>, THEY ARE JUST <u>BEING A</u> CHILD... THAT'S WHAT CHILDREN DO.
- 2. NOTE: IT IS RARE FOR AN ARGUING CHILD TO BE A TRULY HAPPY CHILD.
 - a. ARGUMENTS DO NOT PRODUCE HAPPINESS!
- 3. IN ADDITION, WHEN OUR CHILDREN BEGIN ARGUING WITH US <u>WE</u> TEND TO BECOME ANGRY, ANXIOUS, OR BOTH.
 - a. IF WE BECOME ANXIOUS WE CAVE IN AND COMPROMISE.
- 4. SOOO... TAKE A DEEP BREATH AND CONSIDER THE ABSURDITY OF PARENTS NEGOTIATING AND COMPROMISING WITH THEIR CHILDREN!
 - a. DO GENERALS <u>NEGOTIATE</u> WITH PRIVATES?
 - b. DO **CEOS NEGOTIATE** WITH PEOPLE WORKING IN THE **MAIL ROOM**?
 - c. <u>THAT'S ABSURD</u>... <u>BUT</u> IT'S THE NATURE OF THOSE WHO PROPOSE POST MODERN PROFESSIONAL PARENTING ADVICE.
 - d. IN THIS CASE <u>POST MODERN MENTAL HEALTH ADVISORS</u> TELL

 <u>PARENTS TO UNDERMINE THEIR OWN AUTHORITY</u> RIGHT IN FRONT

 OF THEIR CHILDREN!
 - 1) **UN-BE-LIVE-ABLE!!...** HOW DID WE EVER FALL FOR THAT ADVISE IN THE FIRST PLACE?
- 5. STEP 5 WHEN CHILDREN DO NOT GET AN EXPLANATION... THEY WILL WANT ONE... AND BECAUSE THEY WANT AN EXPLANATION, THEY ASK FOR ONE.
 - A. WHYYY... OR WHYYY NOT??
 - B. <u>WHEN</u> YOUR CHILDREN ASK FOR AN EXPLANATION... SAY THE MOST DEMONIZED FOUR WORDS IN THE HISTORY OF CHILD-REARING... BUT, AT THE SAME TIME, THEY ARE THE <u>FOUR MOST POWERFUL WORDS</u> IN THE HISTORY OF CHILD-REARING... "<u>BECAUSE I SAID SO"</u>!
 - C. <u>MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS</u> WILL TELL YOU THAT SAYING, "BECAUSE I SAID SO" TO A CHILD IS DISRESPECTFUL.

- 1. NO, IT IS NOT.
- 2. YOU HAVE JUST SAID TO YOUR CHILD, "DO THIS".
- 3. <u>THEREFORE</u>, THE <u>ANSWER TO</u> "<u>WHY</u>" IS, IN FACT, <u>BECAUSE YOU JUST</u> "<u>SAID SO</u>".
- 4. WE ARE <u>NOT OBLIGATED TO JUSTIFY OURSELVES TO OUR CHILDREN</u>.
 - a. KEEP THAT IN MIND.
- D. WE MUST NOT SCREAM, "BECAUSE I SAID SO".
 - 1. WE MUST NOT SNARL, "BECAUSE I SAID SO".
 - 2. WE MUST NOT SAY, "BECAUSE I SAID SO" IN A THREATENING MANNER.
 - 3. WE MUST NOT <u>HAVE A RED FACE</u> AND <u>FLAIL OUR ARMS</u> WHILE SAYING, "BECAUSE I SAID SO".
 - a. JUST SAY IT IN A FIRM MANNER... "BECAUSE I SAID SO".
 - b. Ephesians 6:1 (NASB) "Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right."
 - 1) "IN THE LORD" MEANS THAT CHILDREN SHOULD OBEY THEIR PARENTS' INSTRUCTIONS AS IF IT WAS GOD HIMSELF WHO WAS GIVING THE COMMAND.
 - c. <u>NOT</u>, "OBEY YOUR PARENTS BECAUSE THEY <u>JUSTIFY THEMSELVES</u> TO YOU".
 - d. <u>NOT</u>, "OBEY THEM BECAUSE THEY <u>COME UP WITH A SUFFICIENT</u> <u>THREAT</u>".
 - e. <u>NOT</u>, "OBEY THEM BECAUSE THEY COME UP WITH A <u>SUFFICIENT</u> ENTICEMENT".
 - f. SIMPLY, "OBEY YOUR PARENTS BECAUSE IT'S RIGHT"... BECAUSE THEY SAY SO!
- 6. STEP 6 HAVING FOLLOWED THE FIRST 5 STEPS, THE PARENT SHOULD TURN AND WALK BRISKLY AWAY.
 - A. THAT PULLS THE PLUG ON THE POWER STRUGGLE.

- B. IF WE <u>JUST STAND</u> THERE AFTER SAYING "BECAUSE I SAID SO"... <u>A POWER</u> STRUGGLE WILL AMOST ALWAYS ENSUE.
 - 1. <u>NOTHING GETS ACCOMPLISHED</u>, AND <u>IT MAY TAKE HOURS</u> FOR THE CLIMATE IN THE HOME TO RETURN TO A SEMBLANCE OF <u>SANITY</u> AND PEACE.
 - 2. IF WE JUST STAND THERE AFTER SAYING "BECAUSE I SAID SO"... AN ARGUMENT WILL MOST LIKELY HAPPEN.

7. REVIEW

- A. <u>GE</u>TTING CHILDREN TO <u>OBEY</u> IS <u>NOT PRIMARILY A RESULT OF USING</u> CORRECT CONSEQUENCES.
 - 1. <u>ALTHOUGH USING CONSEQUENCES</u> CAN BE VEY HELPFUL AT TIMES.
- B. A SIX PART FORMULA FOR GETTING CHILDREN TO OBEY:
 - 1. <u>STEP 1</u> ADDRESS YOUR CHILDREN FROM AN <u>UPRIGHT POSITION</u>.
 - a. DO <u>NOT</u> BEND DOWN IN A <u>COUNTER-PRODUCTIVE EFFORT</u> TO <u>GET</u> DOWN TO THEIR LEVEL.
 - 2. <u>STEP 2</u> GIVE INSTRUCTIONS USING THE <u>FEWEST WORDS POSSIBLE</u>.
 - 3. <u>STEP 3 PREFACE SHORT INSTRUCTIONS WITH SHORT PHRASES LIKE:</u>
 - a. "IT'S TIME FOR YOU TO..."
 - b. "I WANT YOU TO..."
 - 4. STEP 4 DO NOT EXPLAIN YOURSELF.
 - a. YOU ARE <u>NOT OBLIGATED</u> TO <u>JUSTIFY YOURSELF TO YOUR</u>
 <u>CHILDREN</u>.
 - 5. STEP 5 WHEN YOUR CHILDREN <u>DEMAND</u> TO KNOW <u>WHY</u>, OR <u>WHY</u>

 <u>NOT</u>, USE THE 4 MOST POWERFUL WORDS IN CHILD-REARING

 HISTORY... "<u>BECAUSE I SAID SO"!</u>

- 6. STEP 6 WALK AWAYI
 - a. THAT "PULLS THE PLUG" ON THE POWER STRUGGLE.
 - b. DO <u>NOT ENGAGE IN YOUR CHILDREN</u> BY <u>BECOMING EMOTIONAL</u>... BE THE ADULT!
