



Greetings! We are glad you are considering applying for a summer internship with First Presbyterian Church in Rome, GA!

Program Details:

- Duration: 11 Weeks over Sunday May 16th – Sunday August 8, 2026 (1 Week of vacation during the summer pending supervisor approval)
- Key Dates:
 - Internship Start – Sunday May 16
 - HS RYM – June 8 – 13, 2026
 - MS Summer Camp – June 22 – 26, 2026 (tentative)
 - Internship End – August 8, 2026
- Housing arrangements will be provided through a host family in our church, if needed.

The **Objective** for our student ministry intern program is to

- Invest in and disciple key students for Christ's mission in our world,
- Give each intern an opportunity to identify and develop gifts for work and ministry in God's kingdom and serve the student ministry by providing programmatic and relational help during two key summer months.

Summer Intern **Responsibilities** will include

- Participating in staff meeting and discipleship time (3-6 hrs)
- Sharing program responsibilities like teaching, program development, relational outreach, etc. (20-30 hours)
- Work on special projects of personal or practical interest to the ministry (up to 6 hours)
- Other responsibilities as assigned.

Qualifications required:

- A passionate, growing faith in Jesus and consistent participation in ministry and/or local church
- Agreement with the EPC (Evangelical Presbyterian Church)'s Westminster Confession and "Essentials of the Faith" (www.epc.org)
- Relational skills, strong work ethic, and personal integrity
- Completion of at least one year of college

- Final candidates will be required to complete a background check and agree to the FPC Leadership Standards for all teachers and leaders.

Applications consist of three parts:

- 1) A one-page **Resume** which details your contact information, employment and education history, skills, and gifts. Please send as a PDF via email.
- 2) A completed **Application** (p. of this document) – emailed to robe@fpcrome.org
- 3) **Two Letters of Recommendation**: 1 from non-family and 1 from a pastor or church/ministry leader. Please supply contact information for those writing letters and remind them of the deadline.
