


RETAIN, REVIVE, RESET!

Introduction

- Historically, the church's ministry
 has been inwardly focused;
 however, if it is to significantly
 impact the community and the
 world, it must undergo a hard
 Reset.
- This reset involves helping local church ministries understand that we are called to engage those outside the church and become intentional about our community impact.







RATIONALE

The continued decline in church attendance and membership in mainline Protestant churches, along with recent events (a global public health crisis, a severe economic downturn, cries for justice and police accountability, and the looming presidential election), continue to challenge local churches to re—think what it means to be the church.

Every congregation will do well in assessing every aspect of its ministry, including its understanding of Community Engagement and Impact.

As we do so, we will inevitably have ministries that we will RETAIN, some we will need to REVIVE, and others that will require us to RESET!

INTRODUCTION

- General Decline: The share of U.S. adults who belong to a church, synagogue, or mosque dropped from 70% in 1999 to 47% in 2020, marking the first time it fell below 50% since Gallup began tracking the data in 1937
- Millennials and Gen Z: Younger generations are significantly less likely to attend religious services. For instance, only about 36% of Millennials say they attend religious services regularly, compared to 51% of Baby Boomers.
- COVID-19 Impact: The pandemic exacerbated the decline. Many churches saw a drop in attendance even after reopening post-2020.

KEY DRIVERS BEHIND THE DECLINE:

Secularization: More people, especially younger generations, are identifying as non -religious or "spiritual but not religious."

Cultural Changes: Societal shifts in values, such as the acceptance of LGBTQ+ rights, have led to a disconnect between the church's teachings and personal beliefs.

Technology and Social Media: Technology offers alternative forms of community and connection that have lessened the traditional role of churches.

Pandemic Impact: COVID-19 accelerated church closures and disengagement, with many people not returning to in -person services after lockdowns.

This global pattern suggests a significant transformation in religious practice and belief systems, with many people moving away from formal institutions while maintaining some personal spirituality.





RESET: Ministries that must adapt or




DEFINE WHAT IT MEANS TO "RETAIN" MINISTRIES

DEFINE WHAT IT MEANS TO "REVIVE" MINISTRIES

- Revitalizing programs that have lost momentum but hold potential
- Re-engaging congregants in activities that may have faded

KEY QUESTIONS

- How can we breathe new life into these ministries?
- What can we do to make them relevant today?

RESET



DEFINE WHAT IT MEANS TO "RESET" MINISTRIES



- Define what it means to "Reset" ministries:
- Ministries that need a total overhaul or fresh approach
- New opportunities to meet emerging needs (digital outreach, mental health support)

KEY QUESTIONS

- What ministries no longer serve the current context?
- How do we align new ministry strategies with present challenges?

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT & IMPACT





- Importance of engaging with the wider community:
- Shifting from inward -focused to outward -focused ministries

Examples of impactful engagement:

- After School Mentoring & Tutoring
- Partnerships with local organizations
- Community Outreach


