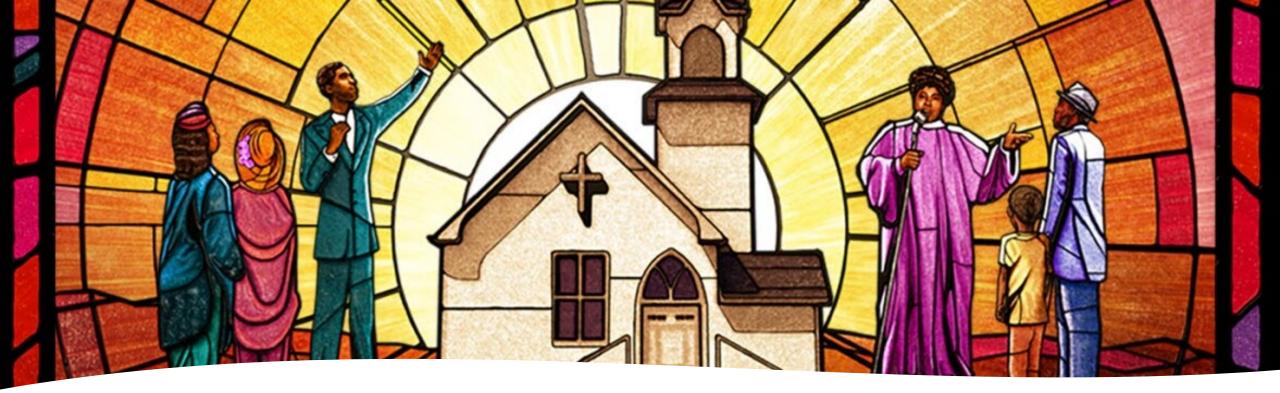
2. Name the 3 most visible areas that hinder your ministry.

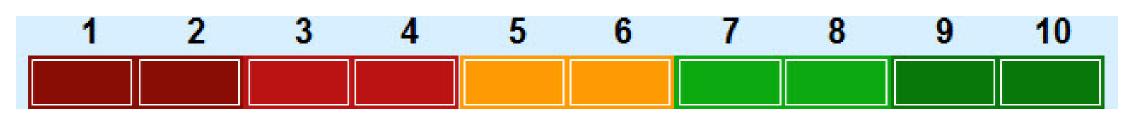
NOTE: Meet with your team once per month over the next six months to discuss implementation status and improve your ministry and shift your church to maximize ministry.

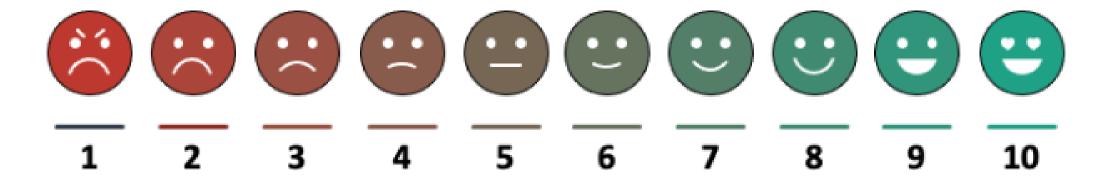


Personal Assessment

11. On your response to number 4, go to someone you trust to be honest with you (your accountability partner) and ask if they agree with your response. If they agree, then with your accountability partner, rate your standing on a scale from 1-10 (1 being the lowest and 10 the highest).
