The Sacrificed Life

Romans 12:1 ESV I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a **living sacrifice**, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

I want you to notice how Paul sets a context of MERCY.

- <u>By</u> the mercies of God
- One translation says, <u>in view</u> of the mercies of God.
- Another says, through the mercies of God.

A holy, pleasing, acceptable life before God has to be built on something, it doesn't come from nothing. And, the beginning of that something is... God's Mercy.

I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice...

"slain before the foundation of the world" Rev 13:8.

1 Corinthians 5:7, "... Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed."

Hebrews 10:12 ESV "When Christ had offered for all time <u>a single sacrifice</u> for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God."

Galatians 1:3,4 NIV Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,4 who gave himself for our sins to rescue us from the present evil age, according to the will (plan) of our God and Father.

The words "gave himself" came alive in my Spirit when I read it.

His sacrifice was a self-giving act of love.

"For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and **to give His life** a ransom for many" (Mark 10:45 nkjv).

1 Peter 2:24 ESV <u>He himself</u> bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.

Ephesians. 5:1,2 Therefore **be imitators** of God, as beloved children. **2** And walk in love, as Christ loved us and (here it is again) gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

THIS IS MERCY and now in view of the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a <u>living sacrifice</u>, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. (back to Rom 12:1)

"The body is given to us to make visible the beauty of Christ." - John Piper

1) The Sacrifice of a Financial Offering.

Philippians 4:18 ESV I have received full payment, and more. I am well supplied, having received from Epaphroditus the **gifts you sent**, a fragrant offering, a **sacrifice acceptable and pleasing to God**.

"In a surrendered life, we often sacrifice the things we love for the One we love even more"

2) The Sacrifice of Good Works.

Hebrews 12:16 ESV Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.

Proverbs 3:9 MSG Honor God with **everything you own**; give him the first and the best.

Romans 12:1 "present your bodies as a **living sacrifice**, holy and acceptable to God, which is **your spiritual worship**"

3) The Sacrifice of Praise.

Hebrews 13:15 NIV Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually **offer** to God a **sacrifice of praise**—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.

Psalm 150 Praise the Lord! Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens! 2 Praise him for his mighty deeds; praise him according to his excellent greatness! 3 Praise him with trumpet sound; praise him with lute and harp! 4 Praise him with tambourine and dance; praise him with strings and pipe! 5 Praise him with sounding cymbals; praise him with loud clashing cymbals! 6 Let everything that has breath praise the Lord!
