- There are two paths in our spiritual walk—Faith & Grace
- Sometimes we walk the path of faith and sometimes the path of grace
- Faith is characterized in doing—discipline, daily habits, lifestyle, work
- Grace is characterized in hearing—obedience, spontaneity, revelation
- Faith is more about what we do
- Grace is more about what God does
- In both, we walk in the Spirit

FAITH

Rev 1:9 I, John, your brother and companion in the suffering and kingdom and patient endurance that are ours in Jesus, was on the island of Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus. NIV

- Faith — brought John to the isle of Patmos
- Suffering — Walking in the Spirit begins with suffering and endurance
- Kingdom — Every enduring kingdom is built through conflict
- Patient Endurance — Defines the faith journey

GRACE

Revelation 1:10-11 On the Lord's Day I was in the Spirit, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet, which said: "Write on a scroll what you see and send it to the seven churches. NIV

- To walk in the Spirit, we must do spiritual things: fast, pray, worship
- Grace comes to us when we are in the spirit
- Grace comes at the Lord's initiative
- But we make a place for Him when we enter into the Spirit
