1 Peter 3:14-16 (ESV)

"14 Have no fear of them, nor be troubled, 15 but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a **defense** to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect, 16 having a good conscience, so that, when you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ may be put to shame."

WHAT IS THE BIBLE?

The Bible is a collection of 66 books or documents broken into two sections (The Old Testament & the New Testament). These 66 books were written over a span of 1,600 years in three different continents.

WHO WROTE THE BIBLE?

"1,600 years, 60 generations, 40 authors different walks of life, different places, different times, different moods, different continents, three languages, writing on hundreds of controversial subjects and yet when they are brought together, there is absolute harmony from beginning to end. There is no other book in history to even compare to the uniqueness of this continuity found in the Bible." (Josh McDowell)

IS IT ACCURATE & CREDIBLE?

What we are finding is that the more we advance in the timeline of history the more we are actually confirming that what we have in our modern Bible is accurate compared to the early manuscripts.

John 5:2 (ESV)

"2 Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, in Aramaic called **Bethesda**, which has five roofed colonnades."

In the book of Acts in the new testament, Luke the author names 32 countries, 54 cities, & 9 islands & all have been located by archaeologist & confirmed Luke was 100% accurate without error in his explanations of where these geographical locations were.
