The following updates were provided: Crossover space is expected to be completed by next week with the exception of some early (not fully implemented) technology. Daniel has really been working hard on infrastructure and technology for the crossover space. Electrical connections to the church have to be re-routed. Plans are in place for this re-route. Family Ministry – Fall Launch Highlights- Matt Provide updates of what is happening in the various ministry areas starting in September	Information	The staff have considered key milestone for children as they progress in ages. For example, a big one is the transition from 4-5 grades and 6-7 grades. The staff have considered how can these key milestones be celebrated? Childrens ministry areas have placed focus on learning how explore the bible. Bibles have been purchased for all first-grade students (and signed by Tony). Classes are full (there are 50 three-year-olds). There is a birthday cart being placed into the lobby. The staff are writing a note for each person with a birthday within the month. There are other bins planned to celebration of other milestones. The IMAGO DEI ministry is focused on caring for adults with special needs. It was reported that people are coming to the church because this ministry exists. Crossover is being led by Nick and Caleb. Caleb will oversee Sunday nights and Nick will oversee Sunday mornings. Movement towards less of a split between junior high and senior high and more of a streamlined integrated approach. Adult Ministry - Both Re-Gen and Re-Engage will begin a new cycle this fall. Both ministries have excellent participation, with many volunteers stepping into significant ownership roles. In addition, this Sunday marks the return of our ABF's for the coming year.
