

Family Advent Activities

Countdown to Christmas

Make a paper chain, alternating red and green colors [for the days leading to Christmas]. On each strip of paper [before putting it together], write people's names to pray for and then each day when you take off a piece of the chain, pray for the person!

Christmas Cards

Collect Christmas cards, punch holes in them [and put the Christmas cards on a ring] to save them!

Christmas Card Prayers

Keep Christmas cards in a special basket or on a ring, then ask each child to pray for the people who sent the card to your family! Continue throughout the year to bless your friends and family!


