OUTLINE

Arrival/Attendance/ Directed Play

8:55-9:10

Welcome the children and mark them as present on the attendance sheet on the clipboard by the door. Set up the activities and introduce the children to the lesson through these activities. Encourage the kids to participate in both activities as they play together. You may need to ask the kids to come to the different areas so all of them have the opportunity to participate

Make a Mural

- Over the last several weeks, the children have decorated several posters to create a mural for their room. As children are interested, allow them to decorate/ color a poster and hang it on a wall. This week, the children will decorate a camel during first service and a wise man during second service.
- SAY Today we are going to learn when the wise men were told about baby Jesus. We decorated a poster of a camel like they might have rode to find him! Let's hang it on our wall!

Follow the Star

- Help the children to get into a single file line. allow the child in front of to hold the paper star above their head and lead the line around the room. Rotate the children so everyone has a turn to lead the line and hold the star.
- SAY Great job everyone. You followed this small star around our room! In our story today we are going to learn about some men who followed a really big star to find Baby Jesus!

Clean Up and Gather for Story

9:10-9:15

Invite the children to begin cleaning up toys and putting away their activities at 9:10. Then remind them to meet at the carpet for Bible story time. Remind the children that we are going to do our best to be good listeners.

Bible Story

Welcome Song

Memory Verse

• This is the children's third week learning this verse. Review the motions and teach them to any children who have not learned them yet.

God- Point up

o loved us-lay your hands over your heart

and sent us-point forward

His Son- make a motion like you are rocking a baby

1 John 4- hold up 4 fingers10- hold up all 10 fingers

• Have the children join you in saying the verse and doing the motions several times to practice. Ask the children if anyone would like to do the verse on their own. If someone needs help, have them pick a friend or do it with them. If no one volunteers, repeat as a class twice more.
