OUTLINE

Arrival/Attendance/ Directed Play

10:40-11:05

Welcome the children and mark them as present on the attendance sheet on the clipboard by the door. Set up the activities and introduce the children to the lesson through these activities. Encourage the kids to participate in both activities as they play together. You may need to ask the kids to come to the different areas so all of them have the opportunity to participate.

Make a Mural

- Over the last several weeks, the children have decorated several posters to create a mural for their room. As children are interested, allow them to decorate/ color a poster and hang it on a wall. This week, the children will decorate a camel during first service and a wise man during second service.
- SAY Today we are going to learn when the wise men were told about baby Jesus. We decorated a poster of a wise man! Let's hang it on our wall to see the finished picture of the Christmas story!

Find the Light

- Crack the Glowstick in your bin and shake it so that it lights up. Dim the lights in your room and have all of the children close their eyes. Hide the glowstick somewhere in the room, with the difficulty-level relative to the age of the children in your room.
- SAY Great job everyone! You used the light from the glow stick to help you find it! In our story today, we are going to learn about some men who used the light from a star to help them find Baby Jesus!

Clean Up and Gather for Story

11:05-11:10

Invite the children to begin cleaning up toys and putting away their activities at 9:10. Then remind them to meet at the carpet for Bible story time. Remind the children that we are going to do our best to be good listeners.

Craft/Coloring Page

11:25-11:35

After the story, have the children go to their tables and prepare for a craft to go along with the lesson. Our BIG IDEA of the week is: God Sent us Jesus.

Give each child a "Three Wise Men Visit Baby Jesus" craft page, three paper circles, and three paper crowns. Allow the children to color the page to see the triangles as three different wise men, the bottom as sand, and the top as the night sky. Help the children to glue the circles at the top of the triangles to be heads and the crowns on the circles to be the wise men's crowns.

As children finish, distribute the coloring page with the Creation story on the back for children to continue coloring, have the children place both the craft and coloring sheet in their bin when they are finished.

Memory Verse

- This is the children's third week learning this verse. Review the motions and teach them to any children who have not learned them yet.
 - God- Point up
 - loved us- lay your hands over your heart
 - o and sent us-point forward
 - His Son- make a motion like you are rocking a baby
 - 1 John 4- hold up 4 fingers
 - 10- hold up all 10 fingers
- Have the children join you in saying the verse and doing the motions several times to practice. Ask the children if anyone would like to do the verse on their own. If someone needs help, have them pick a friend or do it with them. If no one volunteers, repeat as a class twice more.

Snack Time at Tables
