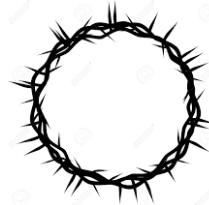

The Easter Story Taught by You!

Use these cards to tell the Easter Story, give each child some Playdoh and have them make a donkey, heart, cross, stone with play doh while you read the verses and talk about the question!
It is scented with Myrrh so they can experience what the scent is in the story!

Tissue Paper Stained Glass Cross

- Carefully peel the back off the clear sticky paper, To keep it in place you can tape the edges down
- Let the kids stick the tissue paper pieces to the paper in the cross to decorate it
- Fold the sticky paper over to seal the cross and cut it out!



Paper Plate Tomb

- Color the card stock pieces of the tomb
- Take the 2 pieces of paper plate and the crosses, stand the crosses above the paper plate
- Tape or staple the plate pieces together at the edges
- Glue or Tape Jesus and the angel
- Use the brad to poke the end into the "He is Risen stone" that will allow it to roll into place and roll back to reveal Jesus is alive inside

Yarn & Cardboard Cross Craft



- Take the Frame and paint or color with markers however you want to design
- Take one strip of yarn and wrap it around vertically, tie the end off when you finish wrapping
- Take the second strip of yarn and wrap it horizontally around the frame, tie the end off when you finish wrapping
- Tie the ribbon in the middle to hold the center of the cross
