Title: Children's Ministry Assistant Director

Reports to: Minister to Children

Purpose: The Assistant Director role is a part-time position responsible for (a) overseeing

the onboarding and training of Shepherds and Junior Shepherds serving in Kids Ministry, (b) overseeing the Welcome Team and visitor follow up process, (c) planning and empowering teams for implementing ministry events and (d) and

other assistance as needed.

#### **Character Traits**

- A passion to see those at LEFC to fall in love with Jesus and live out their relationship with God in their OIKOS.

#### Job Responsibilities

- Lead and further develop Welcome Team and oversee visitor follow-up process.
- Plan, recruit and empower teams to implement special ministry events including but not limited to the following: congregational meeting Kids Ministry, summer Storytime outreach, and Family Christmas Night.
- Assist with planning and recruiting for summer Sundays.

- Serve weekly during one service on Sunday mornings, as Sunday support in our ministry.
- Participate as a member of the LEFC Church Staff and perform other duties as the situation arises/assigned by supervisor.
