# OUTLINE



## Arrival/Attendance/ Directed Play

10:40-11:05

Welcome the children and mark them as present on the attendance sheet on the clipboard by the door. Set up the activities and introduce the children to the lesson through these activities. Encourage the kids to participate in both activities as they play together. You may need to ask the kids to come to the different areas so all of them have the opportunity to participate.

### Do Not Touch

- Place the long string on the floor to create a circle. Have your children walk around inside the circle but explain they must not touch each other, or they will be out. As the game continues make the circle smaller and smaller. Remind your child how people with leprosy were not allowed to touch or get close to others.
- SAY In our Bible story today, we are going to learn about people who were sick with something called leprosy. It gave them lots of spots on their skin. They people around them didn't want to touch them because they were afraid the people who were sick with leprosy were dirty. In our story, we are going to hear how Jesus helped 10 people who were sick with leprosy.

### Number Game

- Pass out the numbers 1-10. Say something such as "if you are holding a number 5, jump up and down. If you are holding 3 or 7, clap your hands." Continue until all the numbers have been called.
- SAY In today's Bible story, we will learn about 10 men who asked Jesus to heal them. Let's learn what happens after Jesus helps them!

## Clean Up and Gather for Story

11:05-11:10

Invite the children to begin cleaning up toys and putting away their activities at 9:10. Then remind them to meet at the carpet for Bible story time. Remind the children that we are going to do our best to be good listeners.





## Bible Story

11:10-11:25

### Welcome Song

- Welcome all the children by singing their welcome song
- (Tune of Twinkle Twinkle Little Star)
- Welcome, Welcome Everyone
- Now you're here Let's have some fun
- First let's clap our hands like so
- Then reach down and touch our toes
- Welcome, Welcome Everyone
- Now you're here Let's have some fun
  - You can call a group of children names to welcome them and they can stand up and wave if you'd like.

The words from today's story are written below. They are taken from pages 405-408 in the Beginner's Bible (2005/2016 edition). Feel free to use the printed images in your bin or the physical Bible in your room to tell the story.

- He threw himself at Jesus' feet and said, "Thank you!" Jesus wondered where the other men were. They did not come back to thank him.






## Craft/Coloring Page

11:25-11:35

After the story, have the children go to their tables and prepare for a craft to go along with the lesson. Our **BIG IDEA** of the week is: Jesus heals our brokenness!

Pass out the picture with Jesus and one of the lepers. Have them color the other nine. Then help them glue the speech bubble that says Thank you. As children finish, distribute the coloring page with today's story on the back for children to continue coloring. Have the children place both the craft and coloring sheet in their bin when they are finished.



## Friends from Afar

11:35-11:45

## Songs/Memory Verse/Prayer

11:45-11:55

There is a list of songs for today's lesson on the TV. Use the directions located with the remote to access them.

**Prayer** (Use these words, or your own, to pray about today's Bible lesson. Take time to listen to prayer requests from the children and pray for them as well!)

- Dear God, thank you for sending your son to heal people. Remind us to thank you for the ways you help us. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.

### Memory Verse

- "Come to me and I will give you rest." **Matthew 11:28**
- Explain that God wants to help us when we need him. This is the children's fourth week learning this verse. For some children you will review the verse but you will also teach other children the motions for this verse:
  - Come to me- point your thumbs toward yourself
  - and I will give- lay your hands flat in front of you with palms up
  - you rest- lay your cheek on your hands like you are sleeping
- Have the children join you in saying the verse and doing the motions several times to practice. Ask the children if anyone would like to do the verse on their own. If someone needs help, have them pick a friend or do it with them. If no one volunteers, repeat as a class twice more.

## Snack Time at Tables

11:55-12:05

Prior to serving the snack have the children use hand sanitizer before choosing a seat at the table. Each child will have veggie straws on a napkin and a small cup of water. **NOTE:** some children with allergies will have their own snack or drink...parents usually remind shepherds of this at drop off. If a question, please contact Kid Min Staff in hallways. Thanks.

While the children are eating their snack, please read the read aloud book that is in the bin labeled Read Aloud book for snack time. Thanks.





## **Free Choice Play**


**12:05-12:15**


# Ten Lepers

“Jesus, please heal us!”





Jesus said, “Go. Show yourselves to the priests.” The ten lepers left. While they were walking away, something amazing happened.




All ten of them were healed! Only one man went back to thank Jesus.

# The Ten Lepers

Luke 17:11-19

Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him.

They stood at a distance and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed.

One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan.

Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?" Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well." (Luke 17:11-19)
