SERMON RECAP

When we try to explain the Trinity, we are often either intimidated by it or oversimplify it. Ultimately, the persons of the Trinity share attributes in glory and exist in perfect love.

THE LEAD IN

- Why is it so hard to talk about and explain the Trinity? Do you tend towards being intimidated or oversimplifying?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read John 14:24-26 and discuss the relationship you see between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- Consider the account of Creation in Genesis 1 and the story of Jesus' baptism in Matthew 3. How do you see the Trinity present in each story? What are the unique roles of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit?

GOING DEEPER

- Creation exists to glorify God as He created all things in perfect love. All sin is against God and does not glorify Him. Yet, through His love, grace abounds. What does that mean for your life? Does it make a difference?
- God models perfect love for us. What might it look like in your Oikos if you grew in the way you love others because of the way God loves and loves you?

PRAYER

- Pray for each other that you would grow in the ways you love each other and extend that love to others around you. Thank God for His perfect example.
