One-year-olds

Our sweet one-year-olds are a delight! And this year, we will be introducing biblical themes for our one-year-olds in our nurseries. Board books, conversation, songs and prayer will be focused on a simple theme for each month. This month the theme is "God Gives Me Food." We will be helping the kiddos develop an awareness that God made food and we can express thankfulness for the good food He gives us.

Two's and Three's

This week, we are learning about the Tower of Babel. We will continue to focus on how God cares for us. Our Bible memory verse is from Luke 1:37, "For nothing is impossible with God."

Pre-K thru 4th Grade


Kid-friendly Resources on Prayer

Important info on new church database system!



We have completed the church management system/directory conversion to our new secure platform called Amplify! Here are a few important things to note:

- You should now remove the old Elexio app. We will no longer be updating any information in Elexio, and it will soon be unavailable
- We have postcards at the Family Check-In Desk and the Welcome Desk with information on how to obtain the new Amplify app, which is called **My Church Home** by Ministry Brands Amplify. Click here to get the new app now!
- In order for you to access the new app, you need to make sure that you are not sharing your email or cell phone number with another family member in the LEFC directory. Please let us know if you need help with this.
- We are still working on fine-tuning Mobile Check-In. After you install the new app, you can use it to check in your children, but the process is a little different than it was with Elexio. When you use the new app to check-in on Sunday mornings, it will generate a QR Code on your phone. You will scan this code at the Family Check-In Desk to print your child and parent tags. If you are not ready or need assistance, please feel free to stop by and we will help. We will make every effort to have an additional station available for check-in
