One-year-olds

Our sweet one-year-olds are a delight! And this year, we will be introducing biblical themes for our one-year-olds in our nurseries. Board books, conversation, songs and prayer will be focused on a simple theme for each month. This month the theme is "Jesus Was a Baby". The focus will be on activities and conversations about Jesus' birth. There will be fun activities, books and coloring pages!
