One-year-olds

Our sweet one-year-olds are a delight! And this year, we will be introducing biblical themes for our one-year-olds in our nurseries. Board books, conversation, songs and prayer will be focused on a simple theme for each month. This month the theme is "God Gives Me Friends." The key Bible verse is John 15:12, "Love each other." The focus will be having the kiddos enjoy happy encounters with other children at church, as well as associate God with happy experiences at church. There will be fun activities, crafts and interactive elements.

Two's and Three's


The 2's/3's classes are learning about when Jesus' Baptism in (Matthew 3:13-17). The big idea for the next six weeks is God's Word never changes. The Bible memory verse is: "The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God endures forever." Isaiah 40:8

Pre-K thru 4th Grade

This week, we'll learn about how Moses confronted Pharoah and how God used Moses to

showcase His glory through Moses' willingness to obey. This unit's memory verse is Psalm 34:17.

Note: During the first service, children in K-3rd grade have a large group story time to engage with the Bible story of the day.



Kids Becoming Like Christ!

This framework begins with concrete thinking: understanding the world through her senses and direct experiences. ...During childhood, her social world shifts from being self-centered toward being others-centered [and to a desire to be valued by others]. ...Many of the choices we make, passions we pursue, and perspectives we articulate as adults can be traced back to what we learned and believed in childhood."

4 Questions to Ponder...

- 1. Every child is in the process of discipleship. The question is who or what is discipling them?
- 2. Consider a day in the life of your child. Or look at a week at-a-glance. Who are the people he or she is following—peers, teachers, your friends from church, church leaders, celebrities, coaches? What are the different kinds of content that your child is taking in through listening, reading, and watching? How much time is spent in various activities and how does this impact how your child is being discipled?
- 3. Reflect on your own childhood and how you were discipled during the first thirteen years of your life. In what ways do you want your child's discipleship to be similar or different?
- 4. How does your childhood experience of discipleship influence the way you're disicpling your children?
