SERMON RECAP

THE LEAD IN

 Think back over your walk with the Lord. Who is the person, or people, who helped you realize that knowing Jesus changes everything?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read what Paul prays for the church in Philippians 1:3-11. Paul's love for the church is evident. He prays for their love to abound to instruct their heads and their hearts. Why is this so important?
- In 1 Thessalonians 2:19-20, we see Paul's similar longing for the church in Thessalonica. How does the abounding love he calls believers to impact both their daily living and their eternity?

GOING DEEPER

- Paul loves the Philippians with "the affection of Christ Jesus." Can you say
 that truthfully about the way you love people? Or are your relationships and
 interactions driven by the convenience, or inconvenience, of others in your
 life or by love?
- How does the abounding love from brothers and sisters in Christ in your life instruct your head and your heart? How is your relationship with God more intimate? How are your relationships together stronger? Are discernment, purity, and blamelessness present in your life because of the love you receive from and show to others?

PRAYER

 Pray that love would abound among you as a group or a family and that love would impact your heads, your hearts, and your interactions with your Oikos.
