GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Philippians 1:19-26. How would you describe Paul's mindset in this passage? What is he motivated by?
- Psalm 34:1-8 paints a picture of David's desire to worship despite difficult circumstances. What does it mean to "taste and see that the Lord is good"? How might this perspective reshape how we engage day-to-day situations?

GOING DEEPER

- Revisit the story you shared earlier about a circumstance becoming bigger than God in your eyes. How did your perspective in that moment shape your emotions, decisions, or reactions?
- The opposite of magnifying God is minimizing God. In what areas of your life are you tempted to minimize God instead of magnifying Him? What would it look like to magnify Him instead in those specific areas?

PRAYER

 Pray for each other that you would each find ways to magnify Christ in your lives this week.
