HUMBLY EXALTED | JULY 6, 2025

SERMON RECAP

Because of Jesus' incredible humility, God hyper exalted Him. One day, every knee will bow and tongue confess that He is Lord. This truth motivates us to urgent mission.

THE LEAD IN

- Share a story where you encountered something so impressively large or powerful that it left you intimidated or in awe. What inspired those feelings?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Philippians 2:5-11 together. How are verses 5-8 and 9-11 tied together? What shift do you see in the passage? How was Jesus' humility so directly tied to his exaltation?
- What does 1 Peter 1:5-6 tell us about what God will do if we live humble lives for His glory? What might our exaltation look like someday?

GOING DEEPER

- Jeff challenged us to consider if we are urgently on mission, or just busy. How would you answer that for yourself? What does or could urgent mission look like?
- In what areas of your life are you exalting yourself and your desires over Christ? How could flipping that on its head open gospel opportunities in your Oikos?

PRAYER

- Pray that you each would seek humility not out of selfish desire, but instead out of a desire to glorify God. Pray for those in your Oikos who you want to see bow their knee in worship of God.
