SERMON RECAP

In light of Jesus' example of humility and servanthood, do not live a life of grumbling and arguing. Rather shine like stars in the sky on a dark night. Be blameless and pure in corrupt times, while you hold firmly to the word of life.

THE LEAD IN

 Living in an area with so much light pollution, we don't get treated to unobstructed views of the beauty of starry nights. Have you ever been somewhere else and been wowed by the night sky?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Philippians 2:14-18. Coming right off the "Christ Hymn" (vs. 6-11), why
 do you think Paul moves into exhortation about not grumbling or arguing?
- Can you think of other times in Scripture when God's people were grumbling? What was the result of their grumbling?

GOING DEEPER

- Stars appear to shine brighter the darker it is. Paul tells us this will be true
 of us if we hold firmly to the word of life. Are you consumed by the things
 of this life, distracted by the things that make you grumble, or do you stand
 out because of Christ?
- What do you consume daily? What is being inflamed in you? Does it cause you to be filled with grumbling or be filled with joy? Does what you consume isolate you or pull you into community?

PRAYER

 Pray for courage to shine Christ in a dark world, not allowing the darkness to cause grumbling and arguing.
