WHERE ARE YOU LOOKING FOR GLORY? | AUGUST 31, 2025

SERMON RECAP

We are either citizens of the world or of heaven. Paul calls believers to live for Christ, follow faithful examples, and seek God's glory over worldly desires.

THE LEAD IN

- Share about a person you admired or imitated growing up. What about them drew you in?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Philippians 3:15-21. How does Paul describe enemies of the cross? What are the things they are pursuing and prioritizing? How does this contrast with Paul's description of a citizen of heaven?
- Why does Paul remind the believers of their citizenship? What values mark citizens of heaven?

GOING DEEPER

- How has God changed the way you think since you've been saved? How did He do it? What did He use to change your mind? Or do you still struggle to remember your citizenship?
- Who is influencing you the most right now? Do their values point you towards Christ or towards distractions of the world?

PRAYER

- Can you think of a person in your Oikos who you'd consider to be an enemy of the cross of Christ? Share those names and spend time praying for them.
