SERMON RECAP

Paul closes his letter to the Philippians with a heartfelt thank you note showing that generosity grows faith, strengthens gospel partnership, and glorifies God.

THE LEAD IN

- Browse back through the book of Philippians. What passages have stood out to you through our study? What reflections from sermons have impacted your heart?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Philippians 4:14-23. In verse 17, Paul says he's more interested in the Philippians growth in Christ than in the gift itself. How does generosity grow our faith and reshape our perspective?
- Paul affirms their gift to him and tells them that God will meet all their needs. How is God meeting our needs different than us expecting Him to meet our wants?

GOING DEEPER

- This section of Philippians reads somewhat like how a global partner thank you letter might sound. How have you seen generosity within the body of Christ meet the needs of someone who is on gospel mission beyond the walls of the church?
- Paul's thank you turns into praise. He points his gratitude and exhortation for generosity back to God. How does remembering that we are citizens of heaven shape the way that we view giving, receiving, and community within the church?

PRAYER

- Pray that as you pursue living with the mind of Christ daily you will be filled with the peace that can come only from Christ.
