GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read 1 John 1:5-7. What do we learn about the nature of God in this text?
 Why does John stress that in Him there is no darkness at all?
- How does Isaiah 5:20 reinforce the warning on blurring truth and error?

GOING DEEPER

- 1 John warns us that if we claim fellowship with God but walk in darkness, we lie to ourselves. What ways to you try to justify or minimize sin even as you pursue walking with Christ?
- When we minimize and justify sin, we are subtly convincing ourselves that we don't need Jesus fully. What might it look like to step into the light and depend on Jesus fully for cleansing?
