SERMON RECAP

Believers are called to remain in the light. Loving one another, modeled after Christ, brings fellowship with the Father. Hating a brother or sister leads to spiritual blindness and darkness.

THE LEAD IN

 Why are many so afraid of the dark? Have you have an experience where darkness created fear or anxiety? Would it have been different in daylight?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read 1 John 2:7-11. John writes that the command to love is both old and new. How is this possible? How does Jesus' life make this command "new" for us today?
- John says that living in the light means loving our brothers and sisters.
 What does this look like in church community? Is it always easy? What happens when we enter fellowship with brothers and sisters who might not be easy to love?

GOING DEEPER

- What might hatred look like in subtle or socially acceptable forms among believers? How can we identify and root out these attitudes before they blind us?
- What is one specific and practical way you can help a brother or sister actively remain in the light this week? How can our group hold each other accountable to walk in love and truth?

PRAYER

 Pray for the boldness to love each other as Christ loves, willing to address issues before hatred or bitterness takes root. Pray for your group to grow increasingly closer through unity in Christ.
