SERMON RECAP

Our confidence comes from our identity in Christ. He is coming back, so as we wait, we are called to be purified, live with childlike faith, and have eternal hope.

THE LEAD IN

- Have you ever been told you look like or act just like one of your parents or a family member? What was it that bore resemblance?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read 1 John 2:28-3:3. In these verses, John is reassuring the church of their identity as children of God. Where and how in this passage do you see him doing this?
- What might it mean to be confident and unashamed before Christ when we meet Him someday?

GOING DEEPER

- Verse 28 tells us that we can be confident and unashamed when Christ appears. What feelings come to mind when you think about the fact that Jesus could return at any moment? Excitement? Fear? Peace? Hope?
- How does accepting your identity of a child of God, living with hope of seeing Christ in the future, and having confidence of being transformed into His image make an impact on your day-to-day life?

PRAYER

- Give thanks to God for making you His children and pray for motivation to continue living boldly for Him so you can stand before Him confidently and unashamed when He returns.
